**Tentative Ruling:**

Elizabeth F. Rojas, chapter 13 trustee (“Trustee”) filed this motion to dismiss pursuant to § 1307(c)(6) due to a material default with respect to the Debtor’s confirmed plan. Trustee gave notice of opportunity to request a hearing pursuant to LBR 3015-1(w) and 9013-1(o). Debtor has filed a response requesting a hearing and stating that the alleged default, including but not limited to any delinquency in plan payments, will be cured at or before the date of the hearing or the debtor will seek a modification of the plan or suspension of plan payments pursuant to LBR 3015-1(n). **Appearances are required.**

The motion is granted. Section 1307(c) provides, in pertinent part, that the court may convert a case under chapter 13 to a case under chapter 7, or may dismiss a case under chapter 13, whichever is in the best interests of creditors and the estate, for cause, including a material default by the debtor with respect to a confirmed plan. 11 U.S.C. § 1307(c)(6). The failure to make timely payments under a confirmed chapter 13 plan is cause for dismissal under § 1307(c)(6). *See Sievers v. Green (In re Green)*, 64 B.R. 530, 531 (9<sup>th</sup> Cir. BAP 1986) (holding that a delinquency in plan payments is grounds for dismissal).

Based upon the evidence presented, the court finds “cause for dismissal under § 1307(c)(6) due to the debtor’s failure to make timely payments to the Trustee in accordance with the confirmed plan; and further, that dismissal of the case would be in the best interests of creditors and the estate. Debtor did not timely file a motion in conjunction with the response seeking a modification of the plan or suspension of plan payments pursuant to LBR 3015-1(n) & (w). Absent payment of the delinquent installments due under the Debtor’s confirmed plan at or before the date of the

**Margulies Faith, LLP.** Margulies Faith, LLP, counsel for the former chapter 7 trustee (“Applicant”), has filed its application for a final allowance of fees and expenses in this case. Applicant has itemized \$21,684.00 in fees and \$871.68 in expenses, for a total of \$22,555.68. No creditor or other party in interest, including the United States trustee, has filed an objection to the application.

The court approved Applicant's employment on March 29, 2016, effective March 9, 2016. Applicant rendered a total of 64.2 hours of services to the estate billed at a blended hourly rate of \$337.76. Applicant's services cover the period from March 9, 2016 through August 30, 2016.

[a] professional person, or . . . any para-professional person” and “reimbursement for actual, necessary expenses.” 11 U.S.C. § 330(a)(1)(A) & (B). In the present case, Applicant was employed to assist in the administration of the estate. The fee application satisfies the requirements of LBR 2016-1(c) and demonstrates that (1) Applicant rendered actual services to the estate that were necessary to the administration of, or beneficial at the time at which the services were rendered toward the completion of, the case, and the compensation sought for such services is reasonable; and (2) the expenses incurred on behalf of the estate for which reimbursement is sought were actual and necessary.

Accordingly, the court allows as final fees the sum of \$21,684.00. The court further allows as final expenses the sum of \$871.68.

**Final Ruling.** This objection to the proof of claim of LoanNow, LLC (Claim No. 11) has been filed by debtor on the notice required by LBR 9013-1 (d)(2) and other applicable rules. The court has considered the motion and will dispense with oral argument. LBR 9013-1(j)(3). **No appearance is necessary.**

The objection is overruled without prejudice. Service of the objection does not comply with FRBP 7004(b)(3) and 9014. The objection was served by sending it to the address on the proof of claim, but not directed “to the attention of an officer, a managing or general agent, or any other agent authorized by appointment or law to receive service of process.” FRBP 7004(b)(3). A claim objection, unless joined with a demand for relief of a kind specified in FRBP 7001, is a contested matter. FRBP 3007, 9013, and 9014. Contested matters are initiated by filing a motion. FRBP 9013. A motion in a contested matter must be served like a summons and complaint. FRBP 9014, incorporating by reference FRBP 7004. FRBP 7004(b)(3) permits service by mail on a corporation provided it is addressed to “an officer, a managing or general agent, or any other agent authorized by appointment or law to receive service of process.” The proof of service indicates that the objection in this instance was simply sent to the corporation, and was not mailed to the attention of “an officer, a managing or general agent, or any other agent authorized by appointment or law to receive service of process.” See *In re Villar*, 317 B.R. 88, 94-95 (9<sup>th</sup> Cir. BAP 2004).

The issue is discussed in detail in *In re Rushton*, 285 B.R. 76 (Bankr. S.D. Ga. 2002). In *Rushton*, the bankruptcy court concluded that an objection to a corporate creditor’s claim could be sent to the address on the proof of claim, but the failure to

mail the objection to the attention of an agent or officer rendered the objection procedurally defective.

“Bankruptcy Rule 2002 does not apply to service of an objection to claim. . . . The request for notices [filed by the claimant’s attorney] entitles [the claimant’s attorney] to receive Rule 2002 notices; but it does not designate the attorney to receive service of process in a contested matter on [the claimant’s] behalf. . . . The procedure for a claim objection is governed by Bankruptcy Rule 3007. . . . Additionally, an objection to a claim is a contested matter subject to Bankruptcy Rule 9014, which requires motions to be served in accordance with Bankruptcy Rule 7004. . . . An objection to a proof of claim of a corporate claimant under Rules 3007 and 7004(b)(3) may be sent to the address of the proof of claim. When perfecting service under Bankruptcy Rule 7004(b)(3), plaintiffs may rely on the address listed on the creditor’s proof of claim. . . . In the instant case, the Debtors were correct in mailing the objection and notice of objection to [the claimant’s] address as listed in the proof of claim. However, Debtors failed to address the objection to an officer or agent and therefore did not properly perfect service. While Debtors are not required to mail service to a named individual officer or agent, at a bare minimum service must be addressed “to the attention of an officer, a managing or general agent or any other agent authorized by appointment or law to receive service of process.”

Id. at 79-81; *see Villar*, 317 B.R. at 94-95. Service in this case was deficient because the objection was not served “to the attention of an officer, managing or general agent or any other agent authorized by appointment or by law to receive service of process.”

Debtor seeks to value the debtor's residence at a fair market value of \$260,000.00. The evidence supports a finding that the subject property had a value of \$260,000.00 as of the date of the petition and the effective date of the plan. *See, e.g., BAC Home Loans Servicing, LP v. Abdelgadir (In re Abdelgadir)*, 455 B.R. 896, 903 (9<sup>th</sup> Cir. BAP 2011) ("[T]he determinative date for whether a claim is secured by a debtor's principal residence is, like all claims, fixed at the petition date."); *Benafel v. One West Bank, FSB (In re Benafel)*, 461 B.R. 581, 587 (9<sup>th</sup> Cir. BAP 2011) (adopting the rule in *Abdelgadir*, but recognizing as a correct approach the valuation of a secured creditor's claim at confirmation). The subject property is encumbered by a first deed of trust lien held by Seterus, Inc., securing a loan with a balance as of the petition date of approximately \$287,366.72. Therefore, Specialized Loan Servicing, LLC's claim secured by a junior deed of trust lien is completely under-collateralized. No portion of this claim will be allowed as a secured claim. *See* 11 U.S.C. § 506(a).

The fact that the junior lienholder's claim is secured only by a security interest in the debtor's principal residence does not prohibit modification. *Zimmer v. PSB*

Furthermore, no interest need be paid on the junior lienholder's wholly unsecured claim except to the extent otherwise required by 11 U.S.C. § 1325 (a)(4).

Valuing the junior lienholder's security and providing the above treatment does not violate In re Hobdy, 130 B.R. 318 (9th Cir. BAP 1991). The plan is not an objection to the junior lienholder's proof of claim pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 502 and FRBP 3007. The plan makes provision for the treatment of the claim and all other claims, and a separate valuation motion has been filed and served in accordance with 11 U.S.C. § 506(a) and FRBP 3012. In addition to serving the plan on all creditors, debtor served the motion to value collateral with a notice that the collateral for the junior lienholder's claim would be valued. The valuation motion is supported by evidence as to the value of the subject property. The content of the notice meets the due process requirement that it be "reasonably calculated, under all of the circumstances, to apprise interested parties of the pendency of the action and to afford them the opportunity to present their objections." Mullane v. Central Hanover Bank & Trust Co., 339 U.S. 306, 314 (1950).

Valuation pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 506(a) and FRBP 3012 is a contested matter initiated by the filing of a motion. FRBP 3012. Valuation does not require the filing of an adversary proceeding. Scott v. Countrywide Home Loans, Inc. (In re Scott), 376 B.R. 285, 291 (Bankr. D. Idaho 2007). Even if considered in the nature of a claim objection, an adversary proceeding is not required. FRBP 3007. The valuation motion does not seek to avoid the lien nor determine the extent, validity, or priority of the security interest. *See* FRBP 7001(2). The court is not determining the validity of a claim or avoiding a lien or security interest. The junior lienholder's deed of trust will remain of record until the plan is completed. 11 U.S.C. § 1325(a)(5)(B)(i).

To the extent that valuation is based on evidence in the form of the debtor's declaration, the debtor may testify regarding the value of property owned by the debtor. Fed. R. Evid. 701; *see* So. Central Livestock Dealers, Inc. v. Security State Bank, 644 F.2d 1056, 1061 (5th Cir. 1980). Given the absence of evidence to the contrary, the debtor's opinion of value is conclusive. *See* Enewally v. Washington Mutual Bank (In re Enewally), 368 F.3d 1165, 1173 (9th Cir. 2004).
