Tentative Ruling:

The Motion fails to explain how 11 U.S.C. § 1322(b)(5) and Federal Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 3002.1 give the court authority to disallow postpetition fees totaling \$1,225.00 claimed by PennyMac Loan Services, LLC ("PennyMac").

Further, the Debtor has not filed a reply, so the assertions made in PennyMac's reply remain unrefuted. Paragraph 14 of the deed of trust, a copy of which is attached to PennyMac's proof of claim, appears to permit PennyMac to seek fees as the creditor argues. The court also notes that Official Form 410S2 contains a line item for "Bankruptcy/Proof of claim fees;" this is a common assertion by creditors.

PennyMac appears to be oversecured, based on the record. 11 U.S.C. § 506(b), which is not discussed in the Motion or the opposition, generally allows oversecured creditors to recover reasonable attorney's fees if there is a fee provision in the loan documents as there is here. The fees are quite low—\$1,225.00—so it is difficult for the Debtor to argue that they are unreasonable for bankruptcy work that includes the preparation of a proof of claim.

Without legal authority for the objection, or a reply to the opposition, there isn't cause to grant the requested relief here.

Tentative Ruling:

Bankruptcy Code Section 330 states that services are compensable if they were "necessary . . . or beneficial at the time at which the service was rendered." 11 U.S.C. § 330(a)(3)(A)(C).

On the petition date, it was not certain what the attorney's fees award would be, so it was not clear that the unsecured debt would be in excess of the 2024 threshold of \$467,725.00. Accordingly, the Frandsens have not shown that Havkin and Shrago assisted the Debtors in filing a petition under chapter 13 that they knew was improper.

The Frandsens assert that there were several problems with the Debtors' plan, and they are correct in noting that no chapter 13 plan was ever confirmed. However, that fact doesn't preclude the allowance of fees for counsel. The court's review of the papers and the record leads to the conclusion that the work done by Havkin and Shrago in this case was necessary and beneficial to the estate; the Frandsens have not shown otherwise.

Finally, the record does not show that the Debtors filed their petition in bad faith and solely for the purpose of delaying and frustrating the Frandsens from collecting the judgment that the Debtors owe to the Frandsens.

The evidence before the court supports Havkin and Shrago's assertion that their services were necessary and beneficial to the Debtors at the time when those services were rendered. The statute and applicable case law support approving the application.
