#### **Tentative Ruling:**

This final report was originally set for hearing in January. However, at the time, the court noted that, due to payment of interim fees from a retainer to chapter 11 counsel for the debtor which was not taken into account by the chapter 7 trustee's final calculations, chapter 11 counsel would be receiving more than other professionals.

Based on the final report, Ms. Frazee would receive \$6,974.39 on account of total fees of \$20,192.50 (about 34.5%). Meanwhile, other ch 11 administrative claims would receive just under 13%.

Rather than recouping any overpayment from Ms. Frazee, the Trustee appears to have addressed this issue by obtaining a stipulation from the other chapter 11 administrative claimant, the subchapter V trustee, to reduce his requested fees from \$18,392 to \$6,750.

The final calculations of chapter 11 professional fee payments are not set forth in the recently filed supplemental declaration of the trustee (Docket No. 173). There is also no amended final report or amended notice of the final report. Finally, there has been no order lodged on the stipulation between the trustee and the subchapter V trustee (Docket No. 170).

The court needs more information to approve the final report. Is the trustee in the position to file some document that clearly sets forth the amounts sought by chapter 11 administrative claimants and the amounts he proposes to distribute on those claims? The trustee should also lodge an order on the stipulation with the subchapter V trustee to reduce his fee request.
