The tentative ruling is to deny approval of this reaffirmation agreement, based on the following:

1. Generally speaking, where a debtor was not represented by an attorney at the time that he signed the agreement, the law requires that the Court approve the reaffirmation agreement before it can become effective. However, Court approval of a reaffirmed debt secured by real property is not required to become effective. See Bankruptcy Code Section 524(c)(6)(B). Here, the debt is secured by a manufactured home, which is considered real property. The agreement became effective upon its signing by both parties.
2. The Court notes that according to Debtor's bankruptcy schedules, his monthly expenses exceed his monthly net income by more than \$1,000 per month. Thus, if Court approval was required, the Court would not have been inclined to approve it.
