Plaintiff AMBI Exclusive Acquisition Co., LLC ("Plaintiff") seeks a judgment against Agnese Purgatorio ("Defendant") for (1) Avoidance of Fraudulent Transfers, (2) Avoidance of Preferential Transfers, (3) Recovery of Avoided Transfers (4) Preservation of Avoided Transfers, and (5) Disallowance of Claim pursuant to the original complaint (the "Complaint") filed on July 29, 2022. Adv. Dkt. 1. The Complaint is based on alleged transfers by the debtor, Jaguar Distribution Corporation (the "Debtor"), to the Defendant between January 2014 through December 2019 totaling approximately \$183,000. Plaintiff alleges the transfers were spousal support payments owed by the Debtor's president, sole board member and sole shareholder, Jeffrey S. Klein ("Klein"), who was divorced from the Defendant 25 years ago.

Plaintiff seeks avoidance of these alleged transfers under §§ 544, 547, 548, 550 and 551 of the Bankruptcy Code and also under California's fraudulent transfer statutes.

Plaintiff filed a motion for default judgment (adv. dkt. 33, the "Motion") which is procedurally and substantively deficient. Procedurally, Plaintiff does not offer any evidence in support of the Motion. Judge Barash's "Judicial Variance Statement" posted on the Court's website expressly states as follows:

LBR 7055-1(b) Motions for Default Judgment: In addition to evidence of the amount of damages, plaintiff must submit admissible evidence to establish all elements of the plaintiff's claim(s) for relief.

Substantively, the Motion fails to provide any legal authority or analysis demonstrating that the allegations of Plaintiff's complaint entitle Plaintiff to a judgment under any of the causes of action in the Complaint. The Motion fails to (i) provide any legal analysis or (i) cite a single case concerning whether the Complaint is sufficiently pled to establish relief under any of the causes of action asserted or (iii) analyze why default judgment would be appropriate.

The rule in the Ninth Circuit is "that default judgments are ordinarily disfavored. Cases should be decided upon their merits whenever reasonably possible." *Eitel v. McCool*, 782 F.2d 1470, 1471-42 (9th Cir. 1986). To enter a default judgment, the Court must consider the following factors: (1) the possibility of prejudice to Plaintiff, (2) the merits of the claims, (3) the sufficiency of the Complaint, (4) the amount of money at stake, (5) the possibility of a dispute concerning material facts, (6) whether default was due to excusable neglect, and (7) the strong policy favoring a decision on the merits. *See Eitel*, 782 F.2d at 1471-72. Plaintiff must brief the *Eitel* factors and demonstrate why entry of a default judgment is warranted in this proceeding.

For each cause of action on which Plaintiff seeks judgment, Plaintiff must provide the elements for such cause of action and legal analysis applying the facts of the case (whether based on the sufficiency of the Complaint or Plaintiff's future proffered evidence) to the law. The Plaintiff must also address the following specific issues:

- 1. The Petition Date in this case is July 31, 2020 (the "Petition Date"). Case Dkt.
 - 1. Exhibit A to the Motion lists alleged transfers between August 27, 2013,

CONT... Jaguar Distribution Corp. Chapter 11 and February 26, 2018, with 29 of the 59 listed transfers occurring more than four years before the Petition Date. The statutes on which the Complaint is based have fraudulent transfer reach-back periods of four years (California Civil Code § 3439.09(a), (b)) or two years (11 U.S.C. § 548(a)(1)). Plaintiff needs to provide law and analysis for why any of the transfers predating July 31, 2016, are avoidable.

- 2. The Complaint alleges that the Defendant is an insider of the Debtor, but it also alleges that Klein and the Defendant were divorced 25 years ago. To the extent Plaintiff is relying on a determination that the Defendant qualifies as an insider of the Debtor, Plaintiff needs to provide law and analysis in support of this allegation.
- 3. The preference claims in the Complaint have reach-back periods of one year, if the transfer is to or for the benefit of an insider (§ 547(b)(4)(B)) and 90 days, if the transfer is not to or for the benefit of an insider (§ 547(b)(4)(A)). None of the transfers listed on Exhibit A to the Motion occurred within one year of the Petition Date. Plaintiff needs to provide law and analysis demonstrating why any of the alleged transfers could be avoided under § 547(b).
- 4. Section 547(b) requires that that the transfer be "for or on account of an antecedent debt owed by the debtor before such transfer was made." 11 U.C. § 547(b)(2). Plaintiff needs to provide law and analysis demonstrating that a spousal support obligation owed by Klein to the Defendant qualifies as a "debt of the debtor" for purposes of § 547(b).
