Counsel for the debtor in possession should be prepared to address two issues at the hearing:

1. Is there anything in the factual record showing whether, as of the petition date, the debtor had and disclosed to individuals a policy prohibiting the transfer of personally identifiable information about individuals to persons that are not affiliated with the debtor? And, if so, whether the proposed sale is consistent with such policy? *See* 11 U.S.C. § 363(b)(1).

Bankruptcy Code section 363(b)(1) provides in relevant part:

[I]f the debtor in connection with offering a product or a service discloses to an individual a policy prohibiting the transfer of personally identifiable information about individuals to persons that are not affiliated with the debtor and if such policy is in effect on the date of the commencement of the case, then the trustee may not sell or lease personally identifiable information to any person unless—

(A) such sale or such lease is consistent with such policy; or

(B) after appointment of a consumer privacy ombudsman in accordance with section 332, and after notice and a hearing, the court approves such sale or such lease—
