The Court will sustain the debtor's objection to proof of claim no. 4-1 filed by Merrick Bank. The Court will disallow proof of claim no. 4-1 in its entirety. **Appearances on June 3, 2026 are waived.**

Background

On October 19, 2020, Hillory Lorie Jo Kozberg (the "Debtor") filed a chapter 13 bankruptcy petition. Dkt. 1. The deadline for creditors to file proofs of claim was December 17, 2025. *See* Dkt. 8 at 2.

On October 17, 2025, Merrick Bank filed proof of claim no. 4-1, asserting a general unsecured claim in the amount of \$5,598.02 based on a credit card (the "Claim"). POC 4-1 at 4. Merrick Bank's attachment to the Claim indicates that the last transaction occurred on June 4, 2017, that the Debtor made her last payment on May 8, 2017, and that the account was charged to profit and loss on December 31, 2017. *Id.*

On February 23, 2026, the Debtor filed an objection to the Claim. Dkt. 45 (the "Objection"). In the Objection, the Debtor requests that the Claim be disallowed because it is unenforceable under the four-year statute of limitations to recover on an account stated. On April 16, 2026, the Court held an initial hearing on the Objection and continued it to June 4, 2026 for supplemental notice on claimant Merrick Bank, an FDIC-insured depository institution, via certified mail in accordance with Rules 3007(a)(2)(A)(ii) and 7004(h) of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure. Debtor's supplemental notice and service of the Objection was timely and proper. *See* Dkt. 53.

To date, neither claimant Merrick Bank, nor any other party in interest, has filed a response to the Objection. "If the claimant does not timely file and serve a response, the court may sustain the objection without a hearing." Local Bankr. R. 3007-1(b)(6); *see also* Local Bankr. R. 9013-1(h) ("if a party does not timely file and serve documents, the court may deem this to be consent to the granting or denial of the motion, as the case may be.").

Discussion

A proof of claim is deemed allowed unless a party in interest objects. 11 U.S.C. § 502(a). A proof of claim constitutes "prima facie evidence of the validity and amount of the claim". Fed. R. Bankr. P. 3001(f); *see also* Fed. R. Bankr. P. 3007. The filing of an objection to a proof of claim under § 502(b) "creates a dispute which is a contested matter" within the meaning of Federal Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 9014 and must be resolved after notice and opportunity for hearing upon a motion for relief. *See* Fed. R. Bankr. P. 9014 advisory committee's note to 1983 amendment.

Upon objection, the proof of claim provides "some evidence as to its validity and amount" and is "strong enough to carry over a mere formal objection without more." *Wright v. Holm (In re Holm)*, 931 F.2d 620, 623 (9th Cir. 1991) (quoting 3 *Collier on Bankruptcy* § 502.02, at 502-22 (15th ed. 1991)); *see also Ashford v. Consol. Pioneer Mortg. (In re Consol. Pioneer Mortg.)*, 178 B.R. 222, 226 (B.A.P. 9th Cir. 1995), *aff'd*, 91 F.3d 151 (9th Cir. 1996). To defeat the claim, the objector must come forward with sufficient evidence and "show facts tending to defeat the claim by probative force equal to that of the allegations of the proofs of claim themselves." *Holm*, 931 F.2d at 623.

"If the objector produces sufficient evidence to negate one or more of the sworn facts in the proof of claim, the burden reverts to the claimant to prove the validity of the claim by a preponderance of the evidence." *Consol. Pioneer Mortg.*, 178 B.R. at 226 (quoting *In re Allegheny Int'l, Inc.*, 954 F.2d 167, 173-74 (3d Cir. 1992)). The ultimate burden of persuasion remains at all times upon the claimant. *See Holm*, 931 F.2d at 623.

A claim may be disallowed to the extent that it "is unenforceable against the debtor and property of the debtor, under any agreement or applicable law for a reason other than because such claim is contingent or unmatured." 11 U.S.C. § 502(b)(1). Under

California law, the statute of limitations to recover on an account stated is four years from the date of the last item on the account. *See* Cal. Civ. Proc. Code § 337(b).

Here, Merrick Bank's attachment to the Claim indicates that the last transaction occurred on June 4, 2017, and that the Debtor made her last payment on May 8, 2017. POC 4-1 at 4. Accordingly, under California law, the statute of limitations applicable to the Claim expired on June 4, 2021. *See* Cal. Civ. Proc. Code § 337(b). Merrick Bank did not file the Claim until October 17, 2025.

Conclusion

The Court will sustain the Objection. Proof of claim no. 4 is disallowed in its entirety. Debtor shall lodge a proposed order.

R. Bankr. P. 3007(a)(1)), the debtor must file and serve a supplemental notice of the objection on claimant Merrick Bank via certified mail addressed to an officer of the institution as follows:

On April 16, 2026, at 9:30 a.m., the Court held an initial hearing on confirmation of the proposed chapter 13 plan filed by debtor Patrick S. Elame (the "Debtor"). *See* Dkt. 2 (notice of hearing); Dkt. 21 (plan). The Debtor appeared in person at the initial hearing. All other appearances were as noted in the record. At the initial hearing, the Court continued the hearing for one month to May 14, 2026, at 9:30 a.m. The Court admonished the Debtor that "this chapter 13 case is headed for dismissal. It's a mess. You're not complying with your obligations under the Bankruptcy Code or the local rules of our court, and next month, if you don't get everything fixed that [the chapter 13 trustee mentioned at the hearing], or make substantial progress, I'm dismissing the case."

On April 22, 2026, the chapter 13 trustee (the "Trustee") filed a *Notice of Continued 341(a) Meeting*, inadvertently setting a continued meeting of creditors for May 14, 2026 at 9:30 a.m. (i.e., concurrent with the continued confirmation hearing) and providing Zoom meeting information regarding the same. Dkt. 26 (notice); Dkt. 39 at 6 (¶ 3, acknowledging notice contained inadvertent mistake as to date and time).

On May 14, 2026, at 9:30 a.m., the Court held the continued confirmation hearing. After a first and second call of the matter, the Court dismissed the case for the Debtor's failure to appear and prosecute. Dkt. 37. After the hearing, at 3:08 p.m., the Debtor called the Trustee's office and indicated that he did not appear because he relied on the Zoom information contained in the Trustee's mistaken notice of the continued meeting of creditors. Dkt. 39 at 6 (¶ 5).

On May 18, 2026, the Trustee filed an amended motion for an order vacating

dismissal of the Debtor's case and resetting the confirmation hearing. Dkt. 39 (the "Motion"). No party in interest filed an opposition to the Motion.

The Trustee's acknowledgement that her notice of the continued meeting of creditors contained an inadvertent mistake establishes cause to vacate the Court's order dismissing the case. *See* Fed. R. Civ. P. 60(b)(1); Fed. R. Bankr. P. 9024 (incorporating Fed. R. Civ. P. 60 to bankruptcy cases). Accordingly, the Court will grant the Motion. The Court will vacate its order dismissing the case. The Court will reset the continued confirmation hearing for July 2, 2026 at 9:30 a.m.

The Trustee shall lodge a proposed order.
