**Tentative Ruling for June 23, 2026**

The Court will grant the motion of Indian Oaks Homeowners Association ("Movant") for relief from the stay applicable to 22611 Lenope Place, Chatsworth, CA 91311 (the "Property") under 11 U.S.C. §§ 362(d)(1), (2) and (4). The Court will waive the 14-day stay otherwise applicable to the Court's order. *See* Fed. R. Bankr. P. 4001(a)(4). The Court will grant the relief requested in paragraph 10 of Movant's prayer for relief, but will not grant the relief requested in paragraph 11. *See* Dkt. 19 at 5 (prayer for relief). Paragraph 10 requests that the Court's order granting the motion be "binding and effective in any bankruptcy case commenced by or against any debtor who claims any interest in the Property for a period of 180 days from the hearing of this Motion ... upon recording of a copy of this order or giving appropriate notice of its entry in compliance with applicable nonbankruptcy law." *Id.* Paragraph 11 goes further than paragraph 10, requesting the Court's order be binding and effective "in any future bankruptcy case, no matter who the debtor may be ... upon record[ation] or ... appropriate notice." *Id.* Movant has already recorded its abstract of judgment against the Property, *id.* at 15 (¶ 11), 42–45, and represented that its foreclosure sale was originally scheduled for April 15, 2026, *id.* at 7 (¶ 9.c). Considering these facts, Movant has not established why the extraordinary relief contemplated in paragraph 10 is not enough, i.e., why the Court's *in rem* order should be effective in perpetuity, rather than for a period of 180 days.

Although not required, the Court makes the following written findings of fact and conclusions of law. *See* Fed. R. Civ. P. 52(a)(3) ("The court is not required to state findings or conclusions when ruling on a motion under Rule 12 or 56 or, unless these rules provide otherwise, on any other motion."); *see also* Fed. R. Bankr. P. 7052 (providing that Fed. R. Civ. P. 52 applies in an adversary proceeding); Fed. R. Bankr. P. 9014(c)(1) (providing that Fed. R. Bankr. P. 7052 applies in a contested matter); Fed. R. Bankr. P. 4001(a)(1) (providing that Fed. R. Bankr. P. 9014 applies to litigation on a motion under § 362(d)).

First, Movant has met its burden of proving that Linda Ann Ferguson ("Debtor") has

no equity in the Property under section 362(d)(2)(A). *See* 11 U.S.C. § 362(g) ("In any hearing ... concerning relief from the stay ..., the party requesting such relief has the burden of proof of the issue of the debtor's equity in the property"). According to Debtor's schedule A/B, the Property's fair market value is \$1,900,000. Dkt. 19 at 103. Her schedule D discloses a first deed of trust against the Property in the amount of \$2,000,000. *Id.* at 113; *see also* Dkt. 17 (mortgage servicer's objection to plan confirmation, indicating that mortgage holder intends to file proof of claim "in the approximate amount of \$2,094,969.58"). Movant holds a junior lien against the Property in the amount of \$112,657.45. *Id.* at 7 (¶ 8.g); *see also id.* at 113 (Sch. D, disclosing Movant's lien in scheduled amount of \$101,000). Accordingly, the Property is over-encumbered in the amount of at least \$212,657, establishing "cause" under section 362(d)(1) and Debtor's lack of equity under section 362(d)(2)(A).

Second, Debtor has not met her burden of proving that the Property is "necessary to an effective reorganization." *See* 11 U.S.C. §§ 362(d)(2)(B), (g). On May 29, 2026 (i.e., 24 days before this hearing), Movant timely and properly served Debtor at the Property's address, her principal residence, with the motion and a notice that she had until June 9, 2026, to file a response. *See* Dkt. 19 at 1–2 (notice), 12 (proof of service); Local Bankr. R. 4001-1(c)(1) (providing rules governing service of motion and notice). To date, no party has filed a response to the motion. *See* Local Bankr. R. 9013-1(g) ("if a party does not timely file and serve documents, the court may deem this to be consent to the granting ... the motion").

Third, cause for relief exists because Debtor is ineligible to be a chapter 13 debtor. According to her own schedules, Debtor's noncontingent, liquidated, secured debts exceed the limit applicable to a chapter 13 debtor by at least \$500,000. *See* 11 U.S.C. § 109(e) ("Only an individual with regular income that owes, on the date of the filing of the petition, ... noncontingent, liquidated, secured debts of less than \$1,580,125 ... may be a debtor under chapter 13"). Moreover, Debtor is ineligible because she is not an "individual whose income is sufficiently stable and regular to enable such individual to make payments under a plan under chapter 13." *See* 11 U.S.C. §§ 101(30), 109(e). Her schedule I indicates she is "not employed." Dkt. 13 at 29. On May 11, 2026, Debtor filed a declaration in which she represented that she had not received income from an employer within 60 days of filing this bankruptcy case. Dkt. 14.

Fourth, cause exists because this case appears to have been filed in bad faith. Movant is one of only a few creditors that Debtor scheduled in this case. Debtor scheduled only two secured creditors in her schedule D: her mortgage servicer and Movant. Dkt. 13 at 16. In her schedule E/F, Debtor scheduled no priority unsecured creditors, and only two nonpriority unsecured creditors, both of whom are credit card issuers. *Id.* At 21. As of June 18, 2026, Debtor has not complied with various requests made by the

chapter 13 trustee, including providing copies of prior income tax returns, bank statements for the six months before the petition date, current paystubs, or an appraisal or broker's price opinion to establish the Property's value as asserted by Debtor. Dkt. 22 (declaration in support of trustee's objection to plan confirmation).

Fifth, the Court finds that this case, Debtor's fourth bankruptcy filing, was part of a scheme to delay, hinder or defraud creditors, including Movant. *See* 11 U.S.C. § 362(d)(4). Debtor's scheme involved five bankruptcy filings affecting the Property, including this case. *See* 11 U.S.C. § 362(d)(4)(B); Case No. 1:24-bk-10944-VK (chapter 13 case affecting Property filed by Gregory Lusk, Debtor's spouse, filed on June 11, 2024, and dismissed on July 25, 2024 for failure to file documents); Case No. 1:20-bk-10386-MT (Mr. Lusk's chapter 13 case affecting Property, filed on Feb. 20, 2020, and dismissed on Apr. 30, 2020, for failure to appear or make plan payments); Case No. 1:19-bk-13184-MT (Mr. Lusk's chapter 13 case affecting Property, filed on Dec. 23, 2019, and dismissed on Jan. 17, 2020, for failure to appear); Case No. 1:19-bk-12017-MT (Debtor's chapter 13 case affecting Property, filed on Aug. 12, 2019, and dismissed on Sept. 4, 2019, with 180-day bar to refile). The Court finds that Debtor was a party to the scheme because Mr. Lusk presented the chapter 13 petition initiating this case at the filing window in the Court's San Fernando Valley division, and then and there presented both his California-issued driver license and hers. *See* Dkt. 2-1; Dkt. 2-2; *see also In re Dorsey*, 476 B.R. 261, 266–68 (Bankr. C.D. Cal. 2012) (holding that bankruptcy court may grant relief under section 362(d)(4) even where debtor is not party to scheme).

Movant shall lodge a proposed order by June 30, 2026. *See* Local Bankr. R. 9021-1(b)(1)(B). Movant shall indicate in its proposed order that the motion is granted based on the Court's written ruling, and shall attach a copy of the relevant pages of the Court's posted calendar.
