THIS TENTATIVE RULING APPLIES TO ALL FEE APPLICATIONS ON CALENDAR IN THIS CASE.

The total of all the professional fees incurred and requested in this case exceeds \$6.3 million. Of that amount, approximately \$2.2 million has been paid and an unpaid balance of approximately \$4.1 million remains. These are very substantial amounts and pertain to years of services provided by multiple professionals.

Based on the Liquidating Trustee's declaration in support of the *First Postconfirmation Status Report*, as of April 14, 2026, the Liquidating Trust held

\$2,116,673.59, of which \$875,648.75 was earmarked for the payment of premiums of life insurance policies.

Is the entire balance to be used to pay allowed professional fees on a pro rata basis? Will that distribution take account of the fact that certain professionals already have received interim distributions?

The Court understands that if the Liquidating Trust litigation is not successful, the allowed professional administrative expenses in this case may never be paid in full. Nevertheless, the Court believes it is obligated to carefully scrutinize the applications. If the litigation is successful to any degree, the outstanding professional administrative expenses will have priority over the distributions to creditors in classes 3c and 3d under the confirmed plan of liquidation.

Following its initial review of the applications, the Court requires each of the applicants to submit an Excel spreadsheet with detailed billing information so that the Court can analyze the fee requests in greater detail.

In the case of applicant Law offices of Elizabeth J. Campbell, the application did not include any detailed time entries. In addition to providing an Excel spreadsheet, Campbell will be required to file on the docket a supplemental declaration attaching and authenticating her time records.

In the case of Christopher Conway and Longevity Asset Advisors, the Court requires supplementary declaration evidence on the history of the Superior Court's rulings on the applications for compensation filed in that Court. Specifically, the application represents that at the time of the bankruptcy filing, their second and third applications were pending before the Superior Court. Case Dkt. 748 at 4-5; Case Dkt 749 at 2.

However, the time entries for the receiver's local counsel (the Levene Neale firm) suggest that the second application was denied without prejudice by the Superior Court. *See* Case Dkt. 751 at 27 ("Confer via email with Receiver and his primary counsel L. Campbell about [the State] Court's August 29 order denying the Receiver's second fee application without prejudice. ...") Applicants should provide a supplemental declaration addressing this apparent discrepancy.
