Reorganized Debtor has paid the IRS \$10,367.96 on account of an alleged secured Class 2 claim. The IRS POC#1 does not assert a secured claim. Why is the Reorganized Debtor making payments to the IRS on account of a secured claim?

4 – Class 9 priority claim of Oshin Harootoonian - \$13,150. The confirmed 3d Amended Plan and the approved 2d Amended Disclosure Statement disclose a \$13,150 priority claim in favor of Oshin Harootoonian based on a priority claim listed on Schedule E. Eight days before the confirmation hearing, the Debtor filed an amended Schedule E – which was not served on Mr. Harootoonian – signed by Eric Weissman listing no priority claims. 5 – **Class 11 Convenience Class - \$1,814.56.** A one-time payment to Class 11 was required to be made within 15 days of the 1/1/25 Effective Date. The status report asserts without explanation that no amounts are required to be paid under the Plan. Why hasn't Class 11 been paid?

6 – **Class 12** – **Subordinated General Unsecured Claims.** The confirmation order expressly states that no general unsecured claims will be subordinated absent further order of the Court. Case Dkt. 221 at 13. Why doesn't the status report address whether the Plan Agent intends to file motions to subordinate some or all of the unsecured claims of the IRS (POC#1 for \$3,758,885.88) or Fresenius USA Manufacturing (POC#7 for \$34,507,942.30).

7 – Administrative Priority Cure Claims of Bio-Rad Laboratories (\$26,475.77) & Blue Shield (\$395.43).
