Tentative Ruling for July 9, 2026

Before the Court is an application filed by the Plan Fiduciary under the confirmed plan of the reorganized debtor. Dkt. 410 (the "Application"). In the Application, the Plan Fiduciary seeks an order of the Court authorizing him to retain Elluma Discovery, Inc. ("Elluma"), and to pay Elluma's fees and expenses from post-confirmation affirmative recoveries. Specifically, the Application seeks authorization to retain Elluma pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 327(a), approval of Elluma's compensation under 11 U.S.C. § 328(a), or alternatively, as a post-confirmation administrative expense under 11 U.S.C. § 503(b). *Id.* at 9 (prayer for relief).

The Court will approve retention and compensation of Elluma, but not under either of the cited statutes.

The confirmed plan states that the Plan Fiduciary's "Expected Duties" include "Investigat[ing]/Liquidat[ing] Estate Claims," which task is contemplated to include "[r]etain[ing] professionals to assist with the investigation and prosecution of estate claims - including but not limited to attorneys and forensic accountants." Dkt. 251 at 21; Dkt. 258 (confirmation order). The confirmed plan further states that:

Plan Fiduciary agrees to perform all 'Plan Fiduciary Services' regardless of whether sufficient funds are recovered to cover the associated fees[.] Plan Fiduciary as well as any agents, professionals or others he employs shall be limited to those funds he recovers through any third-party actions.

The confirmed plan goes on to list specific parameters that concern only the Plan Fiduciary's employment of "Tax Preparation Professionals," "Forensic Accounting Professionals," and "Attorneys." *Id.* at 22–23.

The Plan Fiduciary seeks approval to hire Elluma "to provide electronic discovery services, perform computer forensics activities, prepare reports, consult with attorneys or other agents, and provide testimony as required by" the Plan Fiduciary. *Id.* at 11. The Plan Fiduciary asserts that these services are necessary to prosecute the adversary proceedings he has commenced in accordance with his obligations under the confirmed plan.

Elluma is not a "professional person" within the meaning of 11 U.S.C. § 327.

Not every person employed by a trustee is a "professional person" within the meaning of section 327 of the Bankruptcy Code. *In re California Independent Petroleum Association*, 2022 WL 162439 at *6 (E.D. Cal. Jan. 18, 2022). "A professional person is one who plays an intimate or central role in the administration of the debtor's bankruptcy proceeding." *In re Nine West Holdings, Inc.*, 588 B.R. 678, 693 (Bankr. S.D. N.Y. 2018) (internal quotation marks and citation omitted). "[P]ersons who fall within the specifically delineated groups of 'attorneys, accountants, appraisers, [and] auctioneers' have been appropriately categorized as 'professional persons' under § 327(a)." *In re Marion Carefree LP*, 171 B.R. 584, 588 (Bankr. N.D. Ohio, 1994).

Some courts have considered the following factors in determining whether an employee is a "professional" within the meaning of 11 U.S.C. § 327:

- whether the employee controls, manages, administers, invests, purchases or sells assets that are significant to the debtor's reorganization,
- whether the employee is involved in negotiating the terms of a Plan of Reorganization,
- whether the employment is directly related to the type of work carried out by the debtor or to the routine maintenance of the debtor's business operations;
- whether the employee is given discretion or autonomy to exercise his or her own professional judgment in some part of the administration of the debtor's

estate, i.e. the qualitative approach,

- the extent of the employee's involvement in the administration of the debtor's estate, i.e. the quantitative approach; and
- whether the employee's services involve some degree of special knowledge or skill, such that the employee can be considered a "professional" within the ordinary meaning of the term.

In re First Merchants Acceptance Corp., 1997 WL 873551 at *3 (D. Del. Dec. 15, 1997). A "professional" is limited to those occupations which control, purchase or sell assets that are important to reorganization, is negotiating the terms of a plan of reorganization, has discretion to exercise his or her own personal judgment, and whether he or she contributes some degree of special knowledge or skill. *In re Heritage Home Group LLC*, 2018 WL 4684802, at *3 (Bankr. D. Del. Sept. 27, 2018).

Elluma's limited role in performing technical support and data processing clearly falls *outside* the definition of a professional person whose employment by the estate is subject to the Court's approval under 11 U.S.C. § 327.

Because Elluma is not a "professional person" as that term is used in the Bankruptcy Code, the Court will not approve the Application under 11 U.S.C. §§ 327(a) and 328(a).

The Plan Fiduciary's request for approval of an administrative expense under 11 U.S.C. § 503(b) is inapt in the post-confirmation context.

The Bankruptcy Code provides that, "[e]xcept as otherwise provided in the plan or the order confirming the plan, the confirmation of a plan vests all of the property of the estate in the debtor." 11 U.S.C. § 1141(b). In other words, unless a plan provides otherwise, "[a] bankruptcy estate ... ceases to exist after a reorganization plan is confirmed." *Tighe v. Celebrity Home Ent., Inc. (In re Celebrity Home Ent., Inc.)*, 210 F.3d 995, 998 (9th Cir. 2000) (citing 11 U.S.C. § 1141(b)).

Here, the confirmed plan does not provide for the estate to continue. *See* Dkts. 521, 528. The confirmation order specifically provides that "[p]ursuant to section 1141 of the Bankruptcy Code, upon the Effective Date, the provisions of the Plan shall bind the Debtor" and other parties in interest. Dkt. 528 at 4. Because the estate ceased to

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exist upon confirmation, the Court will not approve the Application under 11 U.S.C. § 503(b).

The Plan Fiduciary is otherwise entitled to the requested order.

The Bankruptcy Code provides that "[t]he court may direct ... any ... necessary party ... to perform any ... act ... that is necessary for the consummation of the plan." 11 U.S.C. § 1142(b). The debtor's confirmed plan directs the Plan Fiduciary to prosecute claims held by the estate, which he has done by filing certain adversary proceedings. The Plan Fiduciary asserts that his retention of Elluma and payment of Elluma's fees and expenses for certain technical services is necessary to make useful to him certain electronic discovery that he has obtained. The Plan Fiduciary further asserts that he will use Elluma's processing of the electronic data to prosecute the adversary proceedings in accordance with the confirmed plan. Therefore, in aid of consummation of the confirmed plan pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 1142(b), the Court will **GRANT** the relief requested in the Application.

Arnold Peter does not have standing to oppose the Plan Fiduciary's application.

"To have standing in bankruptcy court, Appellants must meet three requirements: (1) they must meet statutory 'party in interest' requirements under § 1109(b) of the Bankruptcy Code; (2) they must satisfy Article III constitutional requirements; and (3) they must meet federal court prudential standing requirements." *In re Thorpe Insulation Co.*, 677 F.3d 869, 884 (9th Cir. 2012). "Constitutional standing requires an injury in fact, which is caused by or fairly traceable to some conduct or some statutory prohibition, and which the requested relief will likely redress[.]" *In re Veal*, 450 B.R. 897, 906 (B.A.P. 9th Cir. 2011). Prudential standing "embodies judicially self-imposed limits on the exercise of federal jurisdiction." *Id.* "The prudential standing doctrine or the 'person aggrieved test' provides that '[o]nly those persons who are directly and adversely affected pecuniarily by an order of the bankruptcy court ... have standing to appeal that order." *In re Palmdale Hills Property, LLC*, 654 F.3d 868, 874 (9th Cir. 2011) (quoting *Matter of Fondiller*, 707 F.2d 441, 442 (9th Cir. 1983)). The order must diminish one's property, increase one's burdens, or detrimentally affect one's rights. *See Fondiller*, 707 F.2d at 443.

Arnold Peter failed to establish standing to oppose the Application. As his basis for standing, his opposition cites 11 U.S.C. § 1109(b) and a purported order entered by this Court instructing the debtor to serve him with documents, without citing the

docket number of that purported order. Dkt. 412 at 6. To the Court's knowledge and upon review of the docket in this case, no such order exists. Even if it did, such an order does not plausibly satisfy any of the standing requirements discussed above with respect to the Application.

Arnold Peter is not a creditor of the estate of the reorganized debtor: he was not listed as a creditor in the debtor's schedules, and he never filed a proof of claim against the debtor's estate. Because he is not a creditor of the reorganized debtor, he cannot plausibly assert he will suffer any pecuniary injury-in-fact from the Court providing the relief sought in the Application. Therefore, he lacks constitutional and prudential standing. For those same reasons, he cannot plausibly argue that the relief sought would diminish his property, impose a burden on him, or detrimentally affect his rights.

Arnold Peter *is* a defendant in an adversary proceeding in which the Plan Fiduciary is the plaintiff. *See Faith v. Bommel et al.*, Adv. No. 1:24-ap-01055-MB. Arnold Peter therefore is a party in interest *in that adversary proceeding*. But that does not confer standing on Arnold Peter to be heard on matters of administration in *the chapter 11 case*—which is precisely what the Application concerns.

Accordingly, the Court will **OVERRULE** Arnold Peter's opposition to the Application for lack of standing.

The Plan Fiduciary shall lodge a conforming proposed order authorizing him to retain Elluma, and to pay Elluma's fees and expenses from post-confirmation affirmative recoveries by July 16, 2026.
