#0.00 All hearings on this calendar will be conducted in Courtroom 303 at 21041 Burbank Boulevard, Woodland Hills, California, 91367. All parties in interest, members of the public and the press may attend the hearings on this calendar in person.

Additionally, (except with respect to evidentiary hearings, or as otherwise ordered by the Court) parties in interest (and their counsel) may connect by ZoomGov videoconference free of charge, using the connection information provided below. Members of the public and the press may only connect to the zoom audio feed, and only by telephone. Access to the video feed by these individuals is prohibited.

Parties in interest may participate by ZoomGov videoconference using a personal computer (equipped with camera, microphone and speaker), or a handheld mobile device (such as an iPhone or Android phone). Members of the public, the press and parties in interest may participate by audio only using a telephone.

Neither a Zoom nor a ZoomGov account is necessary to participate remotely and there are no fees for doing so. Videoconference participants will be required to register before entering the ZoomGov videoconference and certify their eligibility to receive the video feed. Upon confirmation of eligibility, participants will receive an email containing a personal link for accessing the video feed. Participants are encouraged to check their spam folders if they cannot locate the email.

The audio portion of each hearing will be recorded electronically by the Court and that recording will constitute its official record. Recording, retransmitting, photographing or imaging Court proceedings by any means is strictly prohibited.
