BACKGROUND:

On March 8, 2024, Erica Bruce ("Debtor") filed a Chapter 13 voluntary petition. On May 2, 2024, Garden Valley HOA ("Creditor") filed a proof of claim in the total amount of \$79,998.20, of which \$17,306 was classified as secured ("Claim 9"). On May 24, 2024, Debtor filed an objection to Claim 9.

In its claim objection, Debtor argues: (1) any lien held by Creditor was satisfied in full during Debtor's prior bankruptcy case; (2) the recorded lien of Creditor cannot operate as a "continuing lien" and cannot secure future amounts due; and (3) the legal fees asserted by Creditor are unreasonable and are not properly classified as secured.

On June 27, 2024, Creditor filed an opposition, arguing: (1) that the postpetition assessments are secured based on an unpublished decision from the Eastern District; and (2) that its attorney fees are reasonable and that Debtor's objection to the reasonableness of the attorney fees was overruled during the prior case.

On July 2, 2024, Debtor filed a reply.

At this point, it appears the Court is tasked with determining the following two issues:

- 1) Whether the postpetition assessments that become due during the life of the plan are a secured or an unsecured claim; and
- 2) Whether the attorney fees included in Claim 9 are reasonable.

Both of these issues appear to have been ruled on during Debtor's prior bankruptcy case.

APPLICABLE LAW:

Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 502(a), a proof of claim is deemed allowed unless a party in interest objects. Absent an objection, a proof of claim constitutes *prima facie* evidence of the validity and amount of the claim under FED. R. BANKR. PRO. Rule 3001(f). *See Lundell v. Anchor Constr. Specialists, Inc.*, 223 F.3d 1035, 1039 (9th Cir. 2000). When a party files an objection to a proof of claim, that filing "creates a

dispute which is a contested matter" within the meaning of FRBP 9014 and the Court must resolve the matter after notice and opportunity for hearing upon a motion for relief. *Id*.

When a creditor has filed a proof of claim that complies with the rules (thereby giving rise to the presumption of validity), the burden shifts to the objecting party who must "present evidence to overcome the prima facie case." In re Medina, 205 B.R. 216, 222 (9th Cir. B.A.P. 1996). To defeat the claim, the objecting party must provide sufficient evidence and "show facts tending to defeat the claim by probative force equal to that of the allegations of the proofs of claim themselves." Lundell, 223 F.3d at 1039 (quoting In re Holm, 931 F.2d 620, 623 (9th Cir. 1991)). "The objector must produce evidence, which, if believed, would refute at least one of the allegations that is essential to the claim's legal sufficiency." Lundell, 223 F.3d at 1040 (quoting In re Allegheny Int'l, Inc., 954 F.2d 167, 173-74 (3d Cir. 1992)). If the objecting party produces sufficient evidence to negate one or more of the sworn facts in the proof of claim, the burden reverts back to the claimant to prove the validity of the claim by a preponderance of the evidence. See In re Consol. Pioneer Mort, 178 B.R. 222, 226 (9th Cir. BAP 1995), aff'd, 91 F.3d 151 (9th Cir. 1996) (quoting Allegheny Int'l, 954 F.2d at 173-74). The ultimate burden of persuasion remains at all times on the claimant. See Lundell, 223 F.3d at 1039; see also Holm, 931 F.2d at 623.

As is required by LBR 3007-1, "an objection to claim must be supported by admissible evidence sufficient to overcome the evidentiary effect of a properly documented proof of claim executed and filed in accordance with FRBP 3001. The evidence must demonstrate that the proof of claim should be disallowed, reduced, subordinated, re-classified, or otherwise modified."

ANALYSIS:

Regarding the first issue, Creditor's argument in support of the classification of Claim 9 as secured appears to solely rely on the unpublished tentative ruling issued in *In re*

Orejana in the Eastern District. This tentative ruling appears to simply assume that the HOA was secured in that case; there is no analysis regarding whether the HOA was secured.

Given the Davis-Stirling Act, the Bankruptcy Appellate Panel's decision in *In re Guillen*, 604 B.R. 826 (B.A.P. 9th Cir. 2019), and Judge Smith's decision in Debtor's prior bankruptcy case, the Court cannot simply assume that Creditor's post-petition assessments are secured. It does not appear that Creditor has provided any clear argument in support of its argument for a secured claim, other than the 2015 recorded lien --- which, on its own, cannot be the basis for holding that the postpetition assessments are secured pursuant to the above authorities. For that reason, the Court is inclined to SUSTAIN the objection to the extent it seeks to reclassify the secured portion of Claim 9 as unsecured.

Regarding Debtor's objection to the attorney fees in included in Claim 9, the Court notes:

- 1) The Court is hesitant to undo the ruling of Judge Smith absent a very clear basis (and clear record); and
- 2) The actual invoices for the attorney fees were not included in the proof of claim or the claim objection, and appear to have only become part of the record through the opposition.

For this reason, to the extent that Debtor wishes to litigate the attorney fees, the Court is inclined to CONTINUE the matter for Debtor to provide *detailed*, line-by-line, objections to the invoices submitted by Creditor with the opposition. In this situation, where an objection to some of the fees has already been overruled in a prior case, and where the fees themselves are not so egregious as to be patently unreasonable, the Court is not inclined to scrutinize over 40 pages of heavily redacted billing entries on

In this matter, the parties appear to agree on the operative facts, but disagree on application of a California state law provision effective since January 2021. Movant commenced and held a foreclosure proceeding *prepetition*. The Trustee's deed upon sale was neither issued nor recorded by the time of the bankruptcy filing.

The state law provision is CAL. CIV. CODE §2924(m)(c). The pertinent section of this provision provides that:

(c) A trustee's sale of property under a power of sale contained in a deed of trust or mortgage on real property containing one to four residential units pursuant to Section 2924(g) shall not be deemed final until the earliest of the following:

The parties here disagree regarding the effect of the language "shall not be deemed final."

Caselaw on this new provision is extremely limited. The only two cases that either party (or the Court) has identified that discuss this provision are *In re Ford*, 2022 WL 17742285 (Bankr. C.D. Cal 2022) and *In re Hager*, 651 B.R. 873 (Bankr. E.D. Cal. 2023).

Here, Movant has requested that the Court explicitly disagree with *Hager* based on, essentially, equitable grounds.

Unfortunately for Movant, while *Ford* and *Hager* may disagree on the extent to which relation back is available after the enactment of § 2924(m)(c), and possibly the statute's interaction with bankruptcy, neither case appears to support Movant's position. It is not clear how Movant believes the Court should interpret the new statute given that there has been no recording of a trustee's deed and no possible application of the relation back doctrine.

Even if the Court were to construe the relation back provision in a broader sense than it was construed in *In re Hager*, that would not save Movant here. The foreclosure sale occurred nearly four months ago. Title remains with Debtor and it is too late for Movant to afford itself of any relation back period to disrupt that conclusion. In that situation, whether applying the new law or the old law, a Chapter 13 debtor is afforded the opportunity to reorganize the property through a Chapter 13 plan.

Section 362(c)(3)(B) provides that the Court can extend the automatic stay if Debtor "demonstrates that the filing of the later case is in good faith as to the creditors to be stayed."

Here, the evidence submitted in support of the motion does not coherently address the relevant issues --- the reason the prior case was dismissed and whether there was a "substantial change" in the personal or financial affairs of Debtor.

On that basis, the Court is inclined to DENY the motion.
