#### **BACKGROUND:**

On June 4, 2024, Dawna Ludwig ("Debtor") filed her voluntary bankruptcy petition initiating the above-referenced chapter 13 case. Debtor's chapter 13 plan was confirmed on August 12, 2024. In relevant part, Debtor's plan provides for the sale of Debtor's residence located at 22840 Hidden Hills Road, Yorba Linda, CA 92887 (the "Property"). The Property is subject to the secured claim of U.S. Bank Trust National Association ("U.S. Bank").

On January 21, 2025, Debtor filed her motion to approve sale of the Property [Dk. 65] (the "Sale Motion") seeking approval of the sale in the amount of \$2,500,000.00. The Sale Motion was not opposed. On January 29, 2025, U.S. Bank filed its response reflecting a payoff balance for its secured claim through January 29, 2025 in the amount of \$275,425.75 and advising Debtor to obtain a formal payoff statement at or near the scheduled sale closing. The order granting Debtor's Sale Motion (the "Sale Order") was entered on February 20, 2025.

On August 8, 2025, U.S. Bank filed its Motion to Determine Payoff [Dk. 110] (the "Motion"). In the Motion, U.S. Bank represents that after entry of the Sale Order, U.S. Bank provided Debtor with a payoff statement including a payoff amount of \$276,655.98 through March 20, 2025 (the "Payoff Statement"). U.S. Bank further represents that, on March 19, 2025, it made an additional advance in the amount of \$8,286.61 for payment of real property taxes assessed after issuance of the Payoff Statement; this additional advance increases the

payoff amount, as of March 20, 2025, to \$284,942.95. Sale of the Property closed on April 9, 2025 (the "Closing Date"); Debtor, however, failed to obtain an updated payoff statement with the exact amount needed to payoff U.S. Bank's loan as of the Closing Date.

In the subject Motion, U.S. Bank assets that it could properly assert a payoff as of the Closing Date in the amount of \$285,271.59, consisting of the Payoff Statement amount of \$276,655.98, \$329.00 for the per diem of \$16.45 for the twenty (20) days from March 20, 2025 to the Closing Date, and the subsequent tax advance of \$8,286.61. U.S. Bank represents that the chapter 13 trustee made a total distribution to U.S. Bank in the amount of \$276,984.09, which distribution was short by \$8,287.50.

U.S. Bank filed its Motion seeking (i) a determination by the Court that the payoff amount as of the Closing Date is \$285,271.59, and (ii) that additional distribution in the amount of \$8,287.50 must be made to U.S. Bank to complete payoff.

The Chapter 13 Trustee filed comments on U.S. Bank's Motion on August 27, 2025. The Chapter 13 Trustee recommends approval of the Motion on the condition that any order granting the motion contains the following language: "The Trustee is authorized to disburse an additional \$8,286.61 to US Bank, proof of claim no. 7, in the ordinary course of business."

#### **DISCUSSION**

As an initial matter, the Court notes that the Chapter 13 Trustee recommends a disbursement in the amount of \$8,286.61, whereas U.S. Bank requests disbursement in the amount of \$8,287.50. The discrepancy between these amounts is de minimus at \$0.89.

In light of the Chapter 13 Trustee's comments, and the de minimus difference in the amount of the additional disbursement agreed to by the Chapter 13 Trustee, and there being no opposition or response by or on behalf of Debtor, the Court is inclined to GRANT the Motion.

#### TENTATIVE RULING

Based on the foregoing, service being proper, there being no opposition, the Court is inclined to GRANT the Motion, subject to the conditions and including the language set forth in the Chapter 13 Trustee's Comments on the Motion.

#### BACKGROUND:

On April 9, 2025, Kelly Corrine Mancini ("Debtor") filed her voluntary bankruptcy petition initiating the above-referenced chapter 13 case. Pursuant to the Notice of Chapter 13 Bankruptcy Case [Dk. 3], the deadline for all creditors to file a proof of claim in this chapter 13 case was set as June 18, 2025 (the "Bar Date"). Notice of the Bar Date was included with the Notice of Chapter 13 Bankruptcy Case and served on April 12, 2025.

Debtor's chapter 13 case was dismissed on April 28, 2025 for failure to file required documents. Debtor, however, filed a motion to vacate the dismissal of her chapter 13 case; the motion was granted on June 2, 2025. Debtor's chapter 13 case was reinstated and a notice re-setting the 341 meeting date and confirmation hearing [Dk. 24] was issued and served [Dk. 28]. The Bar Date remained set as June 18, 2025.

On July 31, 2025, Schools First Federal Credit Union ("Creditor") filed claim number 7-1 ("Claim 7") on the Court's claims register. Claim 7 represents Creditor's general unsecured claim against Debtor in the amount of \$2,687.60 for "money loaned: overdraft protection loan."

On July 31, 2025, Creditor also filed claim number 8-1 ("Claim 8") on the Court's claims register. Claim 8 represents Creditor's general unsecured claim against Debtor in the amount of \$29,787.64 for "credit card."

Debtor filed her Notice of Objection and Objection to Late-Filed Proofs of Claim of Schools First Federal Credit Union [Dk. 38] (the "Objection"). Debtor objects to Claim 7 and Claim 8 on grounds that both claims were filed after the Bar Date and seeks disallowance of Claim 7 and Claim 8 in full.

No opposition has been filed.

#### APPLICABLE LAW:

Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 502(a), a proof of claim is deemed allowed unless a party in interest objects. Absent an objection, a proof of claim constitutes *prima facie* evidence of the validity and amount of the claim under Fed. R. Bankr. Pro. Rule 3001(f). *See Lundell v. Anchor Constr. Specialists, Inc.*, 223 F.3d 1035, 1039 (9th Cir. 2000). When a party files an objection to a proof of claim, that filing "creates a dispute which is a contested matter" within the meaning of FRBP 9014 and the Court must resolve the matter after notice and opportunity for hearing upon a motion for relief. *Id.* 

When a creditor has filed a proof of claim that complies with the rules (thereby giving rise to the presumption of validity), the burden shifts to the objecting party who must "present evidence to overcome the *prima facie* case." *In re Medina*, 205 B.R. 216, 222 (9th Cir. B.A.P. 1996). To defeat the claim, the objecting party must provide sufficient evidence and "show facts tending to defeat the claim by probative force equal to that of the allegations of the proofs of claim themselves." *Lundell*, 223 F.3d at 1039 (*quoting In re Holm*, 931 F.2d 620, 623 (9th Cir. 1991)).

"The objector must produce evidence, which, if believed, would refute at least one of the allegations that is essential to the claim's legal sufficiency." *Lundell*, 223 F.3d at 1040 (*quoting In re Allegheny Int'l, Inc.*, 954 F.2d 167, 173-74 (3d Cir. 1992)). If the objecting party produces sufficient evidence to negate one or more of the sworn facts in the proof of claim, the burden reverts back to the claimant to prove the validity of the claim by a preponderance of the evidence. *See In re Consol. Pioneer Mort*, 178 B.R. 222, 226 (9th Cir. BAP 1995), *aff'd*, 91 F.3d 151 (9th Cir. 1996) (*quoting Allegheny Int'l*, 954 F.2d at 173-74). The ultimate burden of persuasion remains at all times on the claimant. *See Lundell*, 223 F.3d at 1039; *see also Holm*, 931 F.2d at 623.

As is required by LBR 3007-1, "an objection to claim must be supported by admissible evidence sufficient to overcome the evidentiary effect of a properly documented proof of claim executed and filed in accordance with FRBP 3001. The evidence must demonstrate that the proof of claim should be disallowed, reduced, subordinated, re-classified, or otherwise modified."

#### **DISCUSSION**:

As an initial matter, the Court notes that the proof of service attached to the Objection indicates that the document served was an "Amended Notice of Hearing on Notice of Motion and Motion for Order Reopening Closed Case to File Motion to Avoid Lien Under 11 USC §522(f)." There is no proof of service of the Notice of Objection and Objection; thus, it appears that notice and service of the Objection are improper.

The Court notes that Debtor failed to comply with evidentiary requirements set forth in Local Bankruptcy Rule 3007-1(c)(2). The Objection does not include (i) a copy of the <u>complete</u> proof of claim for Claim 7 (Claim 8, however, is a complete copy) and (ii) the objector's declaration stating that the copies of the claims attached are true and complete copies of the proof of claim on file with the court.

Therefore, the Court is inclined to CONTINUE the Objection for Debtor to comply with the above.

#### **BACKGROUND**

On May 11, 2023, Diana Sharaki ("Debtor") filed a Chapter 13 voluntary petition. On September 27, 2023, Debtor's Chapter 13 plan was confirmed. The plan was subsequently modified once.

On March 6, 2025, Debtor commenced an adversary proceeding against: (1) Real Time Resolutions Inc. and RRA CP Opportunity Trust (collectively, "Real Time"); (2) ZBS Law LLP; (3) Jeffrey Golden, Chapter 7 Trustee; (4) Amrane Cohen, Chapter 13 Trustee; and (5) Homecomings Financial LLC ("Homecomings"). The adversary proceeding was commenced *pro se* and it is difficult to determine the causes of action. The Chapter 13 Trustee was dismissed from the action on June 3. The Chapter 7 Trustee and Homecomings Financial LLC have not made any appearance in this adversary proceeding. ZBS Law LLP filed a motion to dismiss, currently set for hearing on August 21, 2025.

On April 7, 2025, Real Time filed an answer to the complaint. On June 17, 2025, Real

Time filed a motion for judgment on the pleadings (the "Motion"). On July 8, 2025, Debtor filed her opposition. On July 16, 2025, Real Time filed a reply. On July 18, 2025, ZBS Law LLP filed a joinder in the Motion.

The following background is derived from the Motion.

On May 3, 2007, Debtor executed a HELOC secured by a second deed of trust and payable to Homecomings. The deed of trust was assigned to RRA CP Opportunity Trust on June 27, 2023. At the time, the outstanding balance was \$154,981.44.

On April 16, 2012, Debtor received a discharge in a Chapter 7 proceeding.

In October 2023, Debtor commenced an adversary proceeding similar to the instant proceeding. On December 14, 2023, the proceeding was dismissed.

On June 12, 2024, Debtor commenced a second adversary proceeding similar to the instant proceeding. On September 30, 2024, the Court dismissed the action for lacking of standing due to the claim at issue still being property of the estate for Debtor's bankruptcy estate in her prior Chapter 7 case. Debtor's prior bankruptcy was reopened on May 31, 2024 and the claim or claims at issue appear to have been abandoned by the Chapter 7 Trustee on December 5, 2024.

On November 26, 2024, Debtor commenced a third adversary proceeding similar to the instant proceeding. The third proceeding was ultimately dismissed for failure to prosecute on May 1, 2025.

On March 6 --- while the prior adversary proceeding was pending --- Debtor commenced the instant adversary proceeding, once again appearing to be based on the same set of facts as the prior proceedings.

#### DISCUSSION

Having reviewed the pleadings and the record of the case, the Court notes that this adversary proceeding appears to violate the duplicative litigation doctrine given that it was filed during the pendency of the prior proceeding, possibly to obstruct those

proceedings. See Adams v. California Dept. of Health Servs., 487 F.3d 684, 688 (9th Cir. 2007) ("Plaintiffs generally have no right to maintain two separate actions involving the same subject matter at the same time in the same court and against the same defendant.") (quotation omitted). This basic legal doctrine would require dismissal of the instant adversary proceeding.

A review of the complaint in this proceeding, however, reveals that it is so difficult to interpret that either application of the duplicative litigation doctrine or application of a FED. R. CIV. P. Rule 12(c) test is extremely difficult. Fed. R. Civ. P. Rule 12(e), incorporated into bankruptcy proceedings by Fed. R. Bankr. P. Rule 12(b), states:

A party may move for a more definite statement of a pleading to which a responsive pleading is allowed but which is so vague or ambiguous that the party cannot reasonable prepare a response. The motion must be made before filing a responsive pleading and must point out the defects complained of and the details desired. If the court orders a more definite statement and the order is not obeyed within 14 days after notice of the order or within the time the court sets, the court may strike the pleading or issue any other appropriate order.

The Court may, sua sponte, act under Fed. R. Civ. P. Rule 12(e). See Kirkpatrick v. County of Washoe, 792 F.3d 1184, 1191 (9th Cir. 2015) ("The district court may also sua sponte request a more definite statement from the plaintiffs, even if the defendants find the complaint comprehensible.") (citing Anderson v. Dist. Bd. Of Trustees of Cent. Fl. Cmty. Coll., 77 F.3d 364 (11th Cir. 1996); see also Fleites v. MindGeek S.A.R.L., 2022 WL 4456077 at \*13 (C.D. Cal. 2022) ("And the Court is empowered to demand a more definite statement sua sponte."). According to a leading treatise, "the test to determine whether a pleading is in need of a more definite statement has been expressed as whether the pleading is unintelligible, rather than wanting of detail." Here, the Courts find the complaint sufficiently unintelligible as to warrant the ordering of a more definite statement.

As a result, the Court is inclined to issue an order directing Plaintiff to provide a more definite statement.
