The Court has reviewed Creditor David Pena Zamora's Supplemental Brief re Election of Remedies Issues Raised in Response to Zamora's Objection to First Amended Chapter 13 Plan. See Docket No. 41. The Court has also reviewed that Response to Opposition to Confirmation of Plan Filed by Creditor David Pena Zamora, Declarations of Jorge Pineda and Mario A. Juarez in Support Thereof. See Docket No. 43. The Court provided Zamora until August 28, 2025, to augment their opposition to confirmation of the Chapter 13 plan. See Docket No. 39. On September 4, 2025, Zamora filed that Addendum to Creditor David Pena Zamora's Supplemental Brief re Election of Remedies Issues Raised in Response to Zamora's Objection to First Amended Chapter 13 Plan (the "Addendum"). See Docket No. 46. As the Addendum was not timely, the Court will not consider it.

Santa Maria Valley, Inc., in the Superior Court of California, County of Los Angeles (the "State Court"), that Complaint for: 1. Breach of Partnership Agreement; 2. Breach of Purchase Agreement; 3. Breach of the Implied Covenant of Good Faith and Fair Dealing; 4. Conversion of Personal Property; 5. Conversion of Partnership Property; 6. Invasion of Privacy; 7. Breach of Fiduciary Duty; 8. Theft in Violation of Penal Code 496(c); and 9. Accounting (the "Complaint"). See Docket No. 34, Response to Objection to Confirmation of Plan Filed by Creditor David Pena Zamora (the "Reply"), pp. 21-34. On December 12, 2024, the State Court entered that Judgment on Special Verdict (the "Judgment") on the Complaint's first, fourth, and eighth causes of action. See id. at pp. 5-19. As to the breach of partnership agreement cause of action, a finding was made that the Debtor had a partnership interest in J.M. Produce (the "Partnership"), a Partnership in which Zamora was also a partner, and that the Debtor breached the partnership agreement, harming Zamora. See id. at p. 9. A finding was made of Zamora's "[p]ast economic loss" related to the Debtor's breach of the partnership agreement for the Partnership in the amount of \$292,189, with \$0 for "[f]uture economic loss." See id.

On January 29, 2025 (the "Petition Date"), the Debtor filed a voluntary petition for relief pursuant to Chapter 13 of Title 11 of the United States Code. *See* Docket No. 1, *Voluntary Petition for Individuals Filing for Bankruptcy*. The Debtor discloses that he "owns a Produce Business," the Partnership. *See id.*, *Statement of Financial Affairs*, p. 40.

The Debtor filed on the Petition Date that *Original Chapter 13 Plan. See* Docket No. 7. On April 4, 2025, Zamora filed that *Objection to Chapter 13 Plan. See* Docket No. 26. At bottom, Zamora argues that he owns one-half of the Partnership, but the Debtor claims the entirety of the profits of the Partnership to fund the plan. *See id.* at p. 6, lines 10-14. Zamora also argues that the Debtor has made numerous, material misrepresentations and omissions in his schedules. *See id.* at lines 7-10.

On April 15, 2025, the Debtor filed that *Ist Amended Chapter 13 Plan* (the "Plan"). *See* Docket No. 29. On April 18, 2025, Zamora filed *Creditor David Pena Zamora's Objection to 1st Amended Chapter 13 Plan* (the "Objection"). *See* Docket No. 31. The Objection roughly tracks the arguments of Zamora's first objection to the originally filed plan. *See id.*

On May 8, 2025, the Debtor filed the Reply. *See* Docket No. 34. The Debtor argues that under the election of remedies doctrine, Zamora has no interest in the Partnership in light of the Judgment. *See id.*

Analysis

Zamora's Interest in the Partnership

Pursuant to Cal. Corp. Code § 16801(5), "a partnership is dissolved, and its business shall be wound up [] on application by a partner a judicial determination that (A) [t]he economic purpose of the partnership is likely to be unreasonably frustrated[;] (B) [a] nother partner has engaged in conduct relating to the partnership business that makes it not reasonably practicable to carry on the business in partnership with that partner[;] (C) [i]t is not otherwise reasonably practicable to carry on the partnership business in conformity with the partnership agreement."

"[A]n action for judicial dissolution and accounting is not the only permissible action between partners. There is at least one important exception: where one partner excludes the other, repudiates the very existence of the partnership and converts all of the partnership assets, the victim may sue for damages without seeking judicial dissolution and an accounting." *Gherman v. Colburn*, 72 Cal.App.3d 544, 557-58 (1977). "In awarding damages instead of dissolving the partnership, [] [t]he court correctly recognized there is an exception to the rule that the only permissible form of action between partners is judicial dissolution: where one of the partners repudiates the existence of the partnership and converts all of the partnership assets. In such a case, the 'victim' may sue for damages without seeking dissolution of the partnership." *Navarro v. Perron*, 122 Cal.App.4th 797, 802 (2004).

"The reason for the exception is obvious: the guilty partner has breached (i.e., repudiated) the basic agreement which created the partnership. He denies the very existence of a partnership. (This is to be distinguished from a situation in which the guilty party recognizes the existence of a partnership but breaches some obligation in the performance of the partnership agreement not amounting to wrongful dissolution in contravention of the agreement.)." *Gherman v. Colburn*, 72 Cal. App. 3d at 558. Accordingly, "the choice of remedy is vested in the victim, not in the wrongdoer. [] It does not lie in the mouth of the wrongdoer to demand that his victim be limited to that cause of action which is most beneficial to the wrongdoer." *See id.* at 564-65.

Exception to the General Rule Applies

The Debtor asserts that the Creditor's reliance on Gherman is misplaced because that case was decided under the former Cal. Corp. Code § 15038, which has since been repealed. See Docket No. 34, p. 3. While it is true that the Gherman court relied on former Cal. Corp. Code § 15038, that court stated that the former Code section was "merely a codification of that well established principle." Gherman v. Colburn, 72 Cal.App.3d at 562. Ther *Gherman* court explicitly notes that "as a matter of common law principles even without a statute, when a partner wrongfully repudiates a partnership agreement, converts the partnership assets and wrongfully expels the innocent partner, the victim may sue for damages [] and is not limited to the usual action for a judicial dissolution []. [S]ince that date (1857), the California cases have consistently recognized the same principle, which is merely a statement of general partnership law." *Id.* at 561. "When new legislation repeals existing law, statutory rights normally end with repeal unless the rights are vested pursuant to contract or common law." Kleemann v. Workers' Comp. Appeals Bd., 127 Cal.App.4th 274, 283 (2005). Moreover, the exception was reaffirmed in *Navarro* in 2004, well after the repeal of § 15038 in 1999. See Navarro v. Perron, 122 Cal. App. 4th at 802. Therefore, contrary to the Debtor's argument, the exception remains a valid and enforceable principle of partnership law, regardless of the repeal of Cal. Corp. Code § 15038.

In the Complaint, Zamora alleged that the Debtor and other defendants breached the Partnership's agreement by, *inter alia*, "unilaterally expel[ing] [Zamora] from [the Partnership] altogether," and "convert[ed] all JMP's business and assets to [J.M. Produce of the Santa Maria Valley, Inc.], and entity over which [Zamora] has no control." *See* Docket No. 34, pp. 25-27. The Judgment finds in favor of Zamora on the breach of partnership cause of action, and for damages in the amount of \$292,189. *See* Docket No. 27, p. 23. The exception discussed in *Gherman* applies. Zamora sought damages related to the breach of the partnership agreement, and, after trial, received damages.

Election of Remedies Doctrine

The Debtor relies on the election of remedies doctrine to argue that "by electing his legal remedy of monetary damages over any equitable remedies, [Zamora] chose

among inconsistent remedies and abandoned any claim to a continuing interest in the alleged partnership." *See* Docket No. 34, p. 3, lines 2-5.

The *Gherman* court held that "[w]here a partner [] wrongfully repudiates the partnership [] agreement and converts the assets of the partnership [] to his own use and benefit, the victim at least has alternative remedies: he may waive the [] breach and sue to specifically enforce the partnership [] agreement, including the remedy of a judicial dissolution and an accounting and if necessary [] to impress a trust on partnership [] property, or the victim may submit to the repudiation and sue for damages for conversion of his interest in [partnership] assets; or the victim may submit to the repudiation and sue for damages for breach of the [partnership] agreement (including 'profits which might have been made') the same as any other action for damages for breach of any other contract." *Gherman v. Colburn*, 72 Cal.App.3d at 564-565. "A plaintiff may plead cumulative or inconsistent causes of action." *Id.* at 565.

Here, Zamora sued the Debtor, and others, under any number of theories, including conversion and an accounting. Zamora succeeded on his breach of partnership cause of action, and was awarded damages for past economic loss, but no damages for future economic loss. Is the totality of the damages owed Zamora not already decided, absent appeals, and has Zamora not dismissed, by action or inaction, any cause of action for conversion? It seems to the Court that Zamora had his choices of dissolution and accounting, or damages. Apparently, he chose damages. Zamora's argument is that he remains a partner of JMP, even whilst he also argues that he was unilaterally expelled from that partnership, and, even if he were not, he argues that the assets of JMP were transferred to another corporation. How is Zamora to plead alternative causes of action, obtain judgment on one, but claim a default position that he also won on the other?
