This matter was settled by the parties at the May 11, 2023 evidentiary hearing. The Parties subsequently entered into an amended stipulation filed July 28, 2023 [Dk. 416], and approved by the Court on July 31, 2023 [Dk. 417], in which the Parties agreed that:

1. Codding, in his individual capacity and in his capacity as managing member of FWF, and chief executive officer of Rabbit Ridge, stipulates that Leroy E. Codding, IV, Fluid Wine Fund I, LLC, and Rabbit Ridge Wine Sales, Inc. have joint and several liability for payment in the increased amount of \$160,000 to the Bankruptcy Estate of Northern Holding, LLC.
2. If \$160,000 is not received by the Estate by 11:59 p.m. Pacific Prevailing Time on September 12, 2023, either in the form of certified funds or verified funds, the Court shall enter an order adjudicating Codding in civil contempt and consider the imposition of appropriate compensatory and coercive sanctions, including the award of compensatory damages including reasonable attorneys' fees, or civil incarceration to coerce Codding to comply with the Court's orders.

In the status report filed September 13, 2023 [Dk. 421], the Parties acknowledge that the payment has not been made. Mr. Codding, in the status report, offers no legal basis for why the Court should not enter an order adjudicating him in contempt, as he agreed to in the stipulation noted above.

The Court notes that the lack of specificity provided in the Joint Pretrial Stipulation filed December 22, 2023 [Dk. 40] will not serve the purpose of aiding the parties and the Court in preparing for and conducting the trial.

Trustee has asserted claims for turnover and unjust enrichment. Trustee's complaint asserts both that \$298,190.40 was owed, yet Trustee demanded turnover of \$245,050.41.
