Trustee seeks approval of a compromise which would provide for the allowance of the secured claim of Mr. Kurtz in the amount of \$550,000 (resulting in a reduction of over \$200,000), in exchange for payment of the claim from escrow or the proceeds of the sale of the Property.

West Coast Ventures & Resources ("WCVR"), which claims to hold a senior secured claim to that of Mr. Kurtz, filed an objection, objecting solely to the timing of the payment of the claim. WCVR asserts that they have senior rights to payment ahead of Mr. Kurtz, and prematurely paying Mr. Kurtz's claim could possibly prevent WCVR's recovery if their own claim is sustained.

While Trustee asserts that application of the *A&C* factors warrants approval of the compromise, the Court is not satisfied at this time with the explanations put forth by Movant and desires to hear further arguments.

### **Tentative Ruling:**

Tentative for 1/16/24:

The Court is inclined to DENY the Motion as Plaintiff has not met its burden in demonstrating that terminating sanctions are warranted; as set forth below, it is Plaintiff's burden to prove its case, however, Plaintiff has not filed any motions to compel and this motion is filed beyond the relevant cutoff dates. Thus, in the context of a noticed motion, the Court has not previously considered, or been presented with the option of, whether lesser sanctions would have been appropriate.

Plaintiff initiated the instant adversary on November 4, 2022, and Defendant Renee Annis Walz filed an Answer on December 5, 2022 [Dk. 6]. Under FRBP 4005, it is the plaintiff who has the burden of proof in objecting to discharge, not the defendant. Here, Plaintiff requests that the Court impose terminating sanctions.

The Ninth Circuit has stated there are five factors a trial court should weigh in determining whether to issue terminating sanctions (1) the public's interest in expeditious resolution of litigation; (2) the court's need to manage its docket; (3) the risk of prejudice to the defendant; (4) the public policy favoring disposition of cases on their merits; and (5) the availability of less drastic sanctions. *Malone v. U.S. Postal Serv.*, 833 F.2d 128, 130 (9th Cir. 1987) (citing *Thompson v. Hous. Auth.*, 782 F.2d 829, 832 (9th Cir.), *cert. denied*, 479 U.S. 829 (1986).

On May 16, 2023, the Court held the initial status conference in this case and

on July 27, 2023, the Court entered a Scheduling Order [Dk. 22] which provided the discovery and motion cutoff dates. Plaintiff's Motion is premised on Defendant not participating in the litigation; however, Plaintiff did not file any motions to compel before this Court and the deadline to do so has now passed. (A "scheduling conference order is not a frivolous piece of paper, idly entered, which can be cavalierly disregarded without peril." *Johnson v. Mammoth Recreations, Inc.*, 975 F.2d 604, 610 (9th Cir. 1992)).

In the instant case, it is Plaintiff who has the burden to prosecute its case (see, e.g., FRBP 4005). A trial date has been set and Plaintiff can prove up its case at trial. Plaintiff also has an appropriate remedy at trial regarding Defendant's alleged lack of participation in the litigation – it can file a motion in limine to prohibit Defendant from introducing discovery. Finally, and contrary to Plaintiff's assertions, the Court has not considered lesser sanctions.

The disposition of this Motion, and the determination of appropriate sanctions for failing to participate in discovery, is within the Court's discretion, *See Nat'l Hockey League v. Metro. Hockey Club*, 427 U.S. 639, 642, 96 S.Ct. 2778, 49 L.Ed.2d 747 (1976). As the factors under *Malone v. U.S. Postal Serv.*, 833 F.3d 128 (9th Cir. 1987) have not been met, terminating sanctions are inappropriate. Thus, the Court is inclined to DENY the Motion.
