Debtor seeks approval to sell certain property identified on Exhibit 1 to the Motion for \$100,000, subject to an initial overbid of \$10,000, with subsequent increments of \$5,000. The Motion is supported by the declarations of Zhou Ying and Zachery Coats, which are both conclusory and lack foundation for the statements made therein. The Court notes the following issues which prevent the Court from finding that Debtor has met the requisite standards for approval of a sale under 11 U.S.C. § 363(b):

- 1. The Motion is silent with respect to any marketing activities performed by Debtor or how Debtor derived the \$100,000 sale price.
