The late-filed Response filed by Debtors on March 13, 2026 [Dk. 32], although unsupported by evidence, has been considered. The Motion is GRANTED under 11 U.S.C. § 362(d)(1) for cause. The motion reflects that Debtors made no postpetition payments, monthly payments are \$3,731.00, arrears total approximately \$70,889.00, and the loan matures on June 1, 2026. The Motion is DENIED under 11 U.S.C. § 362(d)(2). On this record, Movant has not met its burden under § 362(g)(1) to show that Debtors lack equity in the Property. Using the scheduled value of \$1,170,000.00 and total debt of \$877,918.08, the Property appears to have equity of approximately \$292,081.92. The Court therefore need not reach whether the Property is necessary to an effective reorganization, including in light of Debtors' separate chapter 13 filing, Case No. 26-10812-MH, on March 16, 2026, which does not impact this motion. To the extent Movant seeks waiver of the 14-day stay, that request is granted.

The Court is inclined to GRANT the Motion pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 362(d)(1) with Rule 4001(a)(4) waiver and DENY the requests for annulment and for relief from the co-debtor stay of § 1301.

Debtors do not oppose relief from stay as to possession but request that Movant be prohibited from disposing of business equipment remaining at the premises. The bankruptcy court has authority to determine the scope and application of the automatic stay and to grant appropriate relief under 11 U.S.C. § 362(d). *Gruntz v. County of Los Angeles (In re Gruntz)*, 202 F.3d 1074, 1082 (9th Cir. 2000). Accordingly, while Movant may proceed with the unlawful detainer action and recover possession of the premises, the Court will permit disposition of the business equipment remaining at the premises subject to the following conditions: within 72 hours of entry of the Order granting relief from stay, Movant shall provide written notice to the appropriate representative of the Small Business Administration (“SBA”) holding or asserting a security interest in the equipment of (i) the entry of the Order granting relief from stay and (ii) Movant’s intended actions with respect to the removal, storage, or disposition of the equipment. The Court has reviewed the Motion [Dk. 192], the objection of the Litigation Claimants [Dk. 204], Debtors' reply [Dk. 218], Debtors' supplemental brief and supporting declarations [Dk. 221], and the Factor declaration filed on behalf of ABRA [Dk. 222].

Under Rule 9019, the Court may approve a compromise only upon a finding that it is fair and equitable and in the best interests of the estate. *Woodson v. Fireman's Fund Ins. Co. (In re Woodson)*, 839 F.2d 610, 620 (9th Cir. 1988); *Martin v. Kane (In re A & C Properties)*, 784 F.2d 1377, 1381 (9th Cir. 1986), cert. denied sub nom. *Martin v. Robinson*, 479 U.S. 854 (1986). In making that determination, the Court must form an informed and independent judgment, but it need not conduct a mini-trial on the merits of every underlying dispute. *Protective Comm. for Indep. Stockholders of TMT Trailer Ferry, Inc. v. Anderson*, 390 U.S. 414, 424 (1968); *U.S. v. Alaska Nat'l Bank (In re Walsh Constr., Inc.)*, 669 F.2d 1325, 1328 (9th Cir. 1982). The Court's task is to determine whether the proposed settlement falls within the range of reasonableness. *In re A & C Properties*, 784 F.2d at 1381.

The supplemental filings materially improved the record by providing appraisal evidence for both Properties, evidence regarding ABRA's asserted

debt, and evidence of ongoing marketing efforts. Even so, the parties should be prepared to address the following issues at the hearing:

1. Adequate protection / equity cushion.

Debtors' supplemental papers suggest that, based on Debtors' appraised values and ABRA's asserted debt, the estates may have approximately \$6-7 million in apparent gross equity in the Properties and a potential equity cushion of roughly 50%. If so, the parties should be prepared to explain why the estates must nevertheless make the concessions embodied in the compromise to avoid stay-relief litigation.

2. Pending title reports.

Debtors' supplemental brief states that requested title reports were still not complete. The parties should be prepared to address the extent to which the unresolved encumbrance picture affects the Court's ability to evaluate the fairness and reasonableness of the compromise, particularly where the agreement fixes ABRA's lien treatment as between Debtors and ABRA.

3. Absence of current offers.

Debtors submitted evidence of broker retention, a listing agreement, diligence collection, and a proposed sale timeline. However, Debtors also indicate that no offers have yet been received. The parties should be prepared to address whether the present record sufficiently supports the conclusion that the compromise preserves a realistic and value-maximizing sale opportunity, rather than merely delaying a likely stay-relief dispute.

4. Interim payment burden.

The agreement requires six monthly payments of \$88,750, followed by six monthly payments of \$50,000. The parties should be prepared to address the source of those payments, the estates' current ability to make them, and why those payments are reasonable if ABRA is already adequately protected by the asserted equity cushion.

5. The May 1, 2026 stay-relief trigger.

The Litigation Claimants' principal objection is that the agreement permits

ABRA to seek relief from stay beginning May 1, 2026, shortly after the scheduled confirmation hearing. The parties should be prepared to address whether that provision undercuts the breathing spell the compromise is intended to provide, and why that term is reasonable under the fourth *A & C Properties* factor in light of creditor concerns.

6. Other lender-favorable terms.

The parties should also be prepared to address the reasonableness of the agreement's other material terms, including the Lot Property proceeds formula and the provision granting ABRA a superpriority unsecured claim if it is not paid in full from the sales, and why those concessions are justified as part of the overall settlement.

The San Diego Land Lawyers application should also not be approved as presented; it is framed as an application to employ land-use and real-estate attorneys [Dk. 54], yet the proposed compensation includes not only Robin Munro Madaffer as counsel, but also Mo Sammak, identified as a professional engineer, Farah Mahzari, identified as a traffic engineer, and Kyle Alderman, identified as a public-affairs manager. Although Ms. Madaffer's curriculum vitae is attached, no comparable qualifications are provided for the other proposed billers. The application does not explain whether these non-lawyer professionals are members or regular associates of the firm, outside consultants being included within the proposed retention, or some other category entirely. Nor does it provide enough information regarding their qualifications, their relationship to the firm, or the basis on which their services would properly be compensated under this retention. Some of the services also appear to overlap with that of the Stapleton Group.

The Court requires responses regarding the following:

The Trustee seeks to employ his own firm, Stapleton Group, as financial advisors [Dk. 49]. The application discloses that Mr. Stapleton is both the Chapter 11 trustee and a Senior Managing Director of Stapleton Group, that he shares in whatever compensation Stapleton Group receives, and that Stapleton Group shares in whatever compensation he receives as trustee. That creates a direct economic overlap between the fiduciary and the professional he seeks to employ, which seems to render Stapleton Group not disinterested, or at the very least, raises conflict of interest issues.

In addition, the application states that Stapleton Group reserves the right to have other individuals of the firm perform work in this case as the firm deems appropriate, but those individuals are not identified. As a result, the scope of the retention and the anticipated billing structure in that regard are unknown.

Finally, the Trustee does not explain why he seeks to retain his own firm, as opposed to an independent financial advisor or accountant or why this arrangement is in the best interests of the estate.
