Tentative for 3/19/26 is to GRANT the Motion, under the same terms and conditions as set forth in the Interim Order entered on February 24, 2026 [Dk. 49].

Debtor appears to be compliant with the Court's Interim Order [Dk. 49]: Debtor's weekly cash flow summaries reflect that Debtor is current on its adequate protection payments to the SBA, Debtor has not exceeded the \$110,000 spending limit, and Debtor's Notice [Dk. 65] appears to effectuate proper notice to interested parties. No opposition has been filed.

Continued use may be sought by further motion or by stipulation, so long as the stipulation does not materially modify the terms and conditions in the Interim Order [Dk. 49].

Appearances at the 3/19 hearing are excused.

Tentative for 2/17/26:

Service of the motions ##12.10 through 12.40 on calendar are improper. The Court warned counsel about these issues previously.

Prior to the approval of Debtor's proposed use of cash collateral, Fed. Rule of

Bankr. Proc. 4001 requires service in compliance with Rule 9014. The docket does not reflect that proper service has been effectuated on "each entity with an interest in the cash collateral" as required by Rule 4001(b)(1)(c). Debtor's Supplemental Briefing [Dk. 31] sets out that Toast and Itria Ventures hold interests in Debtor's cash collateral, but the record does not reflect that they have been properly served. As previously noted, although the supporting declarations state that service was made by electronic mail, the record does not establish that the recipients consented to electronic service, which would be required. The same is true for service to utility providers regarding the Utility Motion. According to the proof of service, service is improper.

Across the Omnibus Declaration [Dk. 6], Supplemental Briefing [Dk. 31], Cash Flow Summary [Dk. 32], and Wages Motion [Dk. 26], Debtor has provided several cash flow summaries which present different projections and actuals. Even accepting Debtor's most recent projections, they do not show profitability; they show a timing-based cash forecast with multiple weeks of significant negative net income; alternating weeks of positive and negative net income driven largely by the timing of expenses, which raises a concern as to whether actual profitability is being masked. The Movant fails to provide clear and concise information regarding the finances of the company.

The Wage Motion provides that payments to vendors and insiders, made by pre-petition checks, are to be honored. This is inappropriate and will be denied.

The Debtor improves secured creditor SBA's position by the granting of a super-priority lien without justification. This will be denied.

The Motion to A) Continue Using Its Existing Bank Account For 28 Days Post Petition; And For The Balance of the Case, (B) Continue Using Its Current Merchant Service Account Vendor; (C) Current Payroll Processing Company; And (D) Pay Its Current Day To Day Business Bookkeeper As An Ordinary Business Expense (the "Vendor Motion") is denied. Debtor did not cure any of the issues identified in the Court's prior tentative, nor has Debtor shown that proper service has been effectuated with this motion, despite being given an opportunity to do so. DIP accounts must be established and used for all chapter 11 purposes.

The Court is inclined to deny the motions for failure of proper service and the other reasons stated above, and for other reasons that are stated during the hearing.

Virtual appearances are required.

Tentative for 2/3/26:

This matter is CONTINUED to February 17, 2026 at 10:00 a.m., with supplemental briefing due by 12:00 p.m. on February 9, 2026. Any oppositions to the Motion are due by 12:00 p.m. on February 13, 2026. The Motion presents several deficiencies which require further attention.

First, the docket does not reflect that Debtor properly served all interested parties. Although the supporting declarations assert that the majority of interested parties were served by electronic mail, the record does not establish that the recipients consented to electronic service as required by FRBP 7005.

Second, the Motion does not make the showing required for emergency relief. The Motion is largely conclusory and does not explain why immediate use of cash collateral is necessary to avoid irreparable harm. Neither the Motion nor the Omnibus Declaration [Dk. 6] identifies how much cash Debtor currently holds, and the Motion does not include the statement required by Rule 4001(b)(1)(B) or Form F-4001-2.

Third, the Motion misstates the scope of the SBA's collateral and the nature of cash collateral. The Motion incorrectly suggests that the absence of a deposit account control agreement eliminates the SBA's interest in proceeds and receivables, and it improperly conflates inventory and equipment with cash collateral.

Fourth, the proposed order appears to grant the SBA a superpriority administrative claim in addition to replacement liens, effectively converting

prepetition debt into a postpetition superpriority obligation, rather than limiting adequate protection to protection against any demonstrated diminution in value.

Fifth, Debtor seeks authority to use cash collateral to pay a new bookkeeper for Chapter 11 services even though no application to employ that professional has been approved.

Finally, the financial exhibits attached to the Omnibus Declaration reflect multiple weeks of negative projected net operating cash flow and do not explain how projected shortfalls will be funded.

For these reasons, good cause exists to continue the hearing.
