The Court is inclined to GRANT the motion under 11 U.S.C. § 362(d)(1).

Movant has established a prima facie claim for relief. Movant asserts that Debtor is delinquent fourteen (14) monthly payments of \$27,879.00, with total arrears of \$312,994.52. Movant values the Property at \$3,280,000.00, and asserts that the amount owed is \$3,199,355.62, leaving equity of \$80,644.38 and an equity cushion of approximately 2.45%. A movant, "as the party seeking relief, must first establish a prima facie case that cause exists for relief under §362(d)(1)." *In re Gould*, 401 B.R. 415, 426 (9th Cir. BAP 2009); *citing Duvar Apt., Inc. v. FDIC (In re Duvar Apt., Inc.)*, 205 B.R. 196, 200 (9th Cir. BAP 1996). Once a prima facie case has been established, the burden shifts to the debtor to show that relief from the stay is not warranted. *Id.*; see 11 U.S.C. §362(g)(2).

Debtor filed a late opposition disputing service, value, and the amount of equity. The opposition does not overcome Movant's showing. Debtor's asserted valuation is based on Redfin website information, and Debtor has not shown that Movant is adequately protected. Even using Debtor's numbers, there is insufficient equity to constitute adequate protection. *See In re Mellor*, 734 F.2d 1396 (9th Cir. 1984).

Debtor's service objection is overruled. LBR 4001-1(c)(1)(C) requires service on any entity scheduled by the debtor as holding or claiming an interest in the property. Debtor scheduled Clear Recon Corp. and Shellpoint, neither of whom was separately served. However, the Court finds waiver of that local-rule requirement appropriate under LBR 1001-1(d). Movant has made a sufficient threshold showing, for purposes of this summary stay-relief proceeding, that it is the appropriate party to seek relief. The Motion identifies Movant as the holder of the note and beneficiary or assignee under the deed of trust, states that NewRez services the loan for Movant, and is supported by the declaration of Justin Alexander and the note, allonge, deed of trust, and recorded assignment. Clear Recon appears to be foreclosure-related, and Shellpoint is identified as the loan servicer. Under these circumstances, waiver is appropriate in the interest of justice.

The Court has considered the Debtors' Second Amended Disclosure Statement [Dk. 432] ("Disclosure Statement"), the Second Amended Plan [Dk. 430] ("Plan"), the Consumer Privacy Ombudsman's Objection to Plan [Dk. 434], and the docket as a whole. The majority of the issues identified in the Court's December 10, 2025 tentative (set forth below) appear to have been addressed. pre-Effective Date administrative and professional claims from available funds, expected to include the ERC, and authorizes the Liquidating Trustee to incur and pay post-Effective Date Trust expenses. However, the Plan does not condition effectiveness on receipt of the ERC or identify an interim funding mechanism if ERC proceeds are delayed. The Court has considered the Debtors' Disclosure Statement [Dk. 414], the First Amended Plan [Dk. 412], all related pleadings, and the record in this case. Notice and service appear proper [Dks. 386-389], and no objections have been filed. Nonetheless, the Court is concerned that the proposed Amended Plan is highly speculative, resting on assumptions that raise serious feasibility concerns. In addition, the Disclosure Statement fails to provide adequate information, and the Court is not prepared to approve the Disclosure Statement under 11 U.S.C. § 1125(a). The principal deficiencies in the Disclosure Statement are as follows.

1. Insufficient disclosure of Plan funding. The Plan is funded almost entirely by Debtors' Employee Retention Credit ("ERC") claim, valued at \$1,884,476. The Disclosure Statement, however, fails to disclose: the basis for the ERC valuation; whether the ERC claim has been filed, amended, or accepted by the IRS; the risks of audit, reduction, delay, or disallowance of the ERC claim; the effect of denial or delay of the ERC claim on feasibility and administrative solvency, or any specific alternative funding source. This omission of material risk related to the sole source of Plan funding prevents creditors from making an informed judgment. Under the Ninth Circuit's disclosure requirements, as articulated in *In re Brotby*, 303 B.R. 177, 193-94 (B.A.P. 9th Cir. 2003), and the widely adopted *Metrocraft* standard, see *In re Metrocraft Pub. Services, Inc.*, 39 B.R. 567 (Bankr. N.D.Ga. 1984), a disclosure statement must contain enough information for a hypothetical reasonable creditor to make an informed judgment, including disclosure of the risks, uncertainties, and contingencies associated with the plan's funding sources. Because the ERC refund is the sole meaningful source of plan funding, the failure to disclose the material risks associated with its valuation, timing, and collectability prevents creditors from making the informed judgment required by §1125(a) (1).

2. Feasibility. Debtors' Plan assumes recovery on the ERC claim at 100%. See Disclosure Statement at Ex. B. The Disclosure Statement, however, does not explain how the \$1.884 million figure was calculated; there is no statement about ERC eligibility; there is no information as to whether the ERC has been filed, amended, accepted, or audited; and there is no disclosure of timing expectations for payment. Debtors' Disclosure Statement does not adequately discuss the feasibility of this assumption. The Disclosure

Statement merely states: "Substantially all of the Debtors' assets have been sold, and the Plan provides for the orderly liquidation of the Debtors' assets." There is no discussion of the ERC timing, ERC risks, and the impact on feasibility if the ERC is not promptly received. In addition, there is no disclosure of risks associated with the Plan's funding mechanism. The Disclosure Statement does not address or discuss the potential risks of the ERC funding and there is no mention whatsoever of ERC collection risks, despite this being the only meaningful source of Plan funding. The Disclosure Statement includes only a limited discussion of generic and general bankruptcy case risks.

3. Missing Class 1 creditor information. Exhibit 2, which must identify Class 1 unsecured creditors and claim amounts, is blank. Without this information, creditors cannot evaluate the class composition or dilution. This is a fundamental defect; the Disclosure Statement is missing foundational information required for solicitation. See 11 U.S.C. § 1125(a)(1).

4. Insufficient disclosure of administrative solvency concerns. Exhibit B reflects over \$1.8 million in administrative expenses and only \$82,246 projected for unsecured creditors. The Disclosure Statement does not analyze whether sufficient funds exist to pay administrative and priority claims, explain timing of those payments, or address feasibility if the ERC funds are delayed or not available.

5. Insufficient disclosure of CRO/Liquidating Trustee conflicts of interest. The CRO will become the Liquidating Trustee while also holding significant administrative claims and retaining the same professionals without court oversight. The Disclosure Statement does not disclose or analyze potential conflicts under Ninth Circuit fiduciary standards.

6. Inadequate disclosure of causes of action. The Disclosure Statement preserves all Causes of Action but identifies no potential claims, targets, or expected recoveries.

Under the proposed Amended Plan, Debtors will form the Caduceus Liquidating Trust ("Liquidating Trust") on the Effective Date. All remaining estate property, including the ERC claim and all causes of action, will be

transferred into the Liquidating Trust, and Howard B. Grobstein, the Estates' employed CRO, will be appointed as Liquidating Trustee. Pursuant to the proposed Liquidating Trust Agreement, see Ex. 1, the CRO/Liquidating Trustee will be empowered to collect and liquidate assets, prosecute litigation, resolve claims, hire professionals, and make distributions. The Court notes the following issues of concern with respect to the Liquidating Trust and the Liquidating Trust Agreement:

1. Fiduciary duty and independence. The employed CRO (Grobstein Teeple LLP) acts as the liquidating trustee while being a major administrative claimant. This creates a conflict and appears violative of fiduciary independence.

2. Lack of oversight. Under the Liquidating Trust Agreement, the Liquidating Trustee may hire professionals without court approval and pay monthly at 100%. This creates a risk of unchecked administrative depletion of assets.

3. Overly broad indemnification. The Liquidating Trust Agreement contains overly broad indemnification language. Under the agreement, the Liquidating Trustee and all professionals are not liable unless there is willful misconduct, gross negligence, or fraud. The scope of the Liquidating Trustee indemnification covers almost all conduct including, negligent administration, poor litigation decisions, mishandling of creditor disputes, and self-interested actions not rising to gross negligence. Despite the CRO being a major administrative claimant, hiring his own firm, deciding which causes of action to pursue, and approving his own compensation, the Liquidating Trust Agreement does not exclude conflicted conduct from indemnification. The Liquidating Trust Agreement provides for no court supervision and effectively shields the following self-directed decisions: the Liquidating Trustee may hire professionals without court approval, pay monthly fees at 100%, and settle claims without court approval. This provision has the potential to undermine the applicable fiduciary standard by insulating conflicted fiduciary behavior.

Debtors should be prepared to address the foregoing.
