The Court has an independent duty to examine the reasonableness of the fees and expenses required by retained professionals. *In re Auto Parts Club, Inc.*, 211 B.R. 29, 33 (B.A.P. 9th Cir. 1997). Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 330, the court may award reasonable compensation to a professional person employed under 11 U.S.C. § 327 for actual and necessary services rendered. See, 11 U.S.C. § 330(a)(1)(A). In determining the reasonableness of compensation, the court can consider a variety of factors, including whether the services were necessary to the administration or completion of a case, whether they were performed within a reasonable amount of time commensurate with the complexity, importance, and nature of the issue, and whether the compensation is reasonable based on the customary compensation charged. See, 11 U.S.C. §§ 330(a)(3)(C), (D) and (F).

The billing statements contain multiple entries by attorneys for "assembling," "saving," "uploading," "filing," "preparing" proofs of service, etc. There is also billed time for transmitting and reviewing cm/ecf for what appears to be locating filed documents. These types of services appear to be administrative and clerical and are not properly billed, notwithstanding the fact that the

services were performed by an attorney.

Services that are clerical in nature are properly chargeable to the firm as an overhead expense and not to the bankruptcy estate. *In re Sonicblue, Inc.*, 2006 Bankr. Lexis 1576 (Bankr. N.D. Cal. 2006). The following services and the supervising of any of the following activities may be clerical in nature: downloading files, indexing, locating and retrieving, filing, electronically filing, organizing, forwarding and serving documents, conducting Pacer searches, preparing proofs of service, scheduling or calendaring, and filing and serving pleadings. *Id.*; see also *In re Michael J. Schneider*, 2007 Bankr. Lexis 3652 (Bankr. N.D. Cal. 2007).

Moreover, there are numerous time entries which improperly lump multiple discrete tasks into single entries, preventing the Court from determining the necessity and reasonableness of each individual service. See *Thomas v. Namba (In re Thomas)*, 2009 Bankr. Lexis 4529 (B.A.P. 9th Cir. 2009).

For example, on July 9, 2025, the Applicant billed 3.90 hours for the following: "Drafted Motion to Assume Lease, discussion with Partner re Debtor's ability to assure future performance. Review of Landlord's MFR as Lease from Client unavailable. Follow-up with Partner re lack of lease copy from Client. Receipt of lease copy from Client. Review of lease copy from Client. Revisions after Partner initial review. Final draft candidate to Partner." And on July 22, 2025, the Applicant billed .80 for the following: "Review of MFR #166. Emails to Partner and Creditor counsel re APO and to merge different email chains. Call with Partner re status report due to court related to MFR. Review of Client's response re status of payments. Further emails to Creditor counsel re APO." Entries such as these are pervasive throughout the Applicant's billing.

Accordingly, the Applicant is to submit revised billing statements by May 26, 2026 which omit such clerical entries and separate tasks with sufficient detail to permit evaluation of the time expended on each activity. A continued hearing on the Application will take place on June 9, 2026 at 10:00 a.m.

Tentative for 5/11/26 is to APPROVE fees in the reduced amount of \$187,657.50 and expenses in the amount of \$7,265.37. As set forth below, the Court finds good cause to reduce the fees by \$5,395.00 for clerical and vague billing entries.

The Court has an independent duty to examine the reasonableness of the fees and expenses required by retained professionals. *In re Auto Parts Club, Inc.*, 211 B.R. 29, 33 (9th Cir. BAP 1997).

Services that are clerical in nature are properly chargeable to the firm as an overhead expense and not to the bankruptcy estate. *In re Sonicblue, Inc.*, 2006 Bankr. LEXIS 1576 (Bankr. N.D. Cal. July 20, 2006). Here, the Application includes numerous entries for clerical tasks, including but not limited to filing and serving pleadings, preparing proofs of service, calendaring deadlines, organizing and updating files, coordinating service and courtesy copies, and similar administrative activities performed by paraprofessionals. Accordingly, the Court finds good cause to omit these entries, totaling \$5,395.00, from the approved fees.

Moreover, the Court notes multiple billing entries with allocated portions of entries described as “coordinate follow-up” or “coordinate filing,” without identifying the substance of the task, the parties involved, or the necessity of the service. Such vague descriptions prevent the Court from evaluating
