Movant, as pointed out in its reply, has submitted sufficient evidence demonstrating the property against which relief is sought: all of the trademarks and other property subject to its UCC-1, as identified in several documents.

colorable claim. "A hearing on a motion for relief from stay is meant to be a summary proceeding, and the statute requires 'the bankruptcy court's action to be quick.'" *In re Flores,* 2013 WL 6186262, \*6 (Bankr. C.D. Cal. November 25, 2023).

"Cause" is not defined in the Bankruptcy Code. Instead, this Court must exercise its discretion on a case by case basis to determine whether sufficient cause has been demonstrated to support relief from the automatic stay. *See* e.g., *Christensen v.
