The Court is inclined to APPROVE the final fee applications [Dks. 1613 and 1615] as requested, and OVERRULE Ronnie Jordan's Omnibus Opposition [Dk. 1626].

Under § 327(a), counsel for a debtor in possession must be disinterested and may not hold or represent an interest adverse to the estate. The professional bears the burden of establishing its eligibility and entitlement to compensation, and full disclosure is a prerequisite to both employment and compensation. *Movitz v. Baker (In re Triple Star Welding, Inc.)*, 324 B.R. 778, 789-96 (9th Cir. BAP 2005); *Neben & Starrett, Inc. v. Chartwell Financial Corp. (In re Park-Helena Corp.)*, 63 F.3d 877, 880-82 (9th Cir. 1995). Section 330 permits reasonable compensation for actual and necessary services that were reasonably likely to benefit the estate when rendered. *Roberts, Sheridan & Kotel, P.C. v. Bergen Brunswig Drug Co. (In re Mednet)*, 251 B.R. 103, 108-09 (9th Cir. BAP 2000).

Jordan's objection is based primarily on his contention that the MWP Pledge,

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the Plan compromises, the treatment of MWP's alleged § 509 claim, and the Plan's retention of Robin Mowbray's equity demonstrate that EK sacrificed MWP's interests for Robin's benefit. [Dk. 1626 at 3-18.] Those underlying challenges were raised, or could have been raised, in connection with confirmation. A confirmed plan is binding, and issues pertaining to the plan may not later be pursued through a collateral attack. *Trulis v. Barton*, 107 F.3d 685, 691 (9th Cir. 1997). The Court confirmed the Plan, approved the compromises as fair and equitable, found that the Plan was proposed in good faith and satisfied the best-interests test, and overruled all unresolved objections. [Dk. 1504 ¶¶ 5, 8, 12, 32, 35, 45-46.] The Court later rejected Jordan's renewed challenges to the MWP Pledge and alleged § 509 claim in denying his stay motion. [Dk. 1539 at 9, 12, 16.]

Those findings do not, standing alone, establish that EK had no conflict. A § 1129(a)(3) good-faith finding does not necessarily determine every separate legal issue associated with the Plan, and issue preclusion applies only where the identical issue was actually raised, contested, submitted for determination, and decided. *See Garvin v. Cook Investments NW, SPNWX, LLC (In re Cook Investments NW, SPNWX, LLC)*, 922 F.3d 1031, 1035-36 (9th Cir. 2019); *Janjua v. Neufeld*, 933 F.3d 1061, 1065-66 (9th Cir. 2019). The Court therefore has independently considered Jordan's conflict allegations.

The record does not establish that EK actually held or represented an interest adverse to either estate. EK disclosed its concurrent representation of MWP and Robin at the outset. [MWP Case Dk. 22; Robin Case Dk. 27.] The MWP Pledge, PNC payment, alleged § 509 claim, Plan compromises, and liquidation analyses were known, presented to the Court, and litigated. EK's reply explains why it contends those matters did not create actual adversity. [Dk. 1628 at 16-19.] Jordan identifies potentially different economic interests, but he does not identify evidence that EK suppressed a claim MWP wished to pursue, refused to advance a position for MWP because it would harm Robin, used one client's information against the other, or otherwise allowed the concurrent representation to impair its professional judgment. His theory instead depends principally on obtaining findings contrary to the confirmed Plan.

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Jordan also does not challenge any particular time entry, billing rate, duplication, or category of work as unreasonable under § 330. The Court's independent review of the applications shows that EK performed compensable work in numerous categories beyond the Plan issues challenged by Jordan. Complete forfeiture of all compensation is not supported by the record.

Accordingly, the Court is inclined to approve (1) \$567,115.50 in fees and \$5,641.16 in expenses as requested in Dk. 1613, regarding EK's representation of Mowbray Waterman Property, LLC, and (2) \$141,449.50 in fees and \$2,818.65 in expenses as requested in Dk. 1615, regarding EK's representation of Robin Mowbray.

Tentative for 7/14/26 is to APPROVE fees of \$129,301.50 and expenses of \$3,756.83, for a total award of \$133,058.33. The requested fees are reduced by \$1,775.00 for 7.1 hours of clerical or administrative work billed at \$250 per hour.

The Court has an independent duty to review the reasonableness of compensation requested from the estate, even in the absence of an objection. *Lobel & Opera v. U.S. Tr. (In re Auto Parts Club, Inc.)*, 211 B.R. 29, 33 (9th Cir. BAP 1997). Under 11 U.S.C. § 330(a), compensation may be awarded only for actual, necessary, and reasonable professional services. Purely clerical or administrative work is treated as firm overhead and is not compensable from the estate. *In re SonicBlue Inc.*, 2006 Bankr. LEXIS 1576 (Bankr. N.D. Cal. 2006).

The time records include entries for tasks that did not require legal training or the exercise of professional judgment. Examples include, *inter alia*:

1.5 hours on March 13, 2025 to prepare a proof of service;
0.5 hours on March 14, 2025 to convert JPG photographs to PDF files;
1.7 hours on April 2, 2025 to prepare an amended creditor mailing list;
0.5 hours on April 24, 2025 to update a utility mailing list;
1.0 hour on April 25, 2025 to serve the utility motion; and
1.4 hours on May 16, 2025 to prepare a supplemental creditor list for service.

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The reduction is limited to entries that are plainly clerical. The Court otherwise finds that the services were reasonably necessary to the administration of the case and that the requested rates and remaining time are reasonable. The Forsythe Declaration also states that the Firm provided the fee materials to the Debtor's principal, requested his review, and received no response, which sufficiently addresses the client-declaration requirement under LBR 2016-1(a)(1)(J). No opposition to the Application was filed.

The Court is inclined to DENY the Motion to Dismiss.

A Chapter 7 debtor may obtain dismissal under 11 U.S.C. § 707(a) only for “cause,” and the debtor bears the burden of showing that dismissal would not prejudice their creditors. *Bartee v. Ainsworth (In re Bartee)*, 317 B.R. 362, 365-66 (B.A.P. 9th Cir. 2004); *Hickman v. Hana (In re Hickman)*, 384 B.R. 832, 840-41 (B.A.P. 9th Cir. 2008). In evaluating “cause,” the Court must consider whether dismissal would cause legal prejudice to creditors, and where the alleged misconduct is addressed by a more specific Code provision, that conduct does not itself constitute “cause” under § 707(a). *Neary v. Padilla (In re Padilla)*, 222 F.3d 1184, 1191 (9th Cir. 2000); *Sherman v. SEC (In re Sherman)*, 491 F.3d 948, 969 (9th Cir. 2007).

Debtor has not shown that dismissal would avoid prejudice to creditors. Philips has filed both a proof of claim and an adversary proceeding seeking nondischargeability and denial of discharge, the Chapter 7 Trustee contends that this is an asset case with potentially significant estate property and unresolved transfer issues, and the Chapter 7 trustee for Steven Minn's estate has joined the opposition based on potential estate claims. On this record, dismissal would not merely restore a two-party dispute to state court; it would terminate an active Chapter 7 estate and disrupt pending bankruptcy-specific claims and estate administration.

There are also unresolved issues concerning the Debtor’s disclosures and

prepetition conduct. The Trustee and Philips both identify alleged omissions and inconsistencies in the Debtor's original schedules, including failures to disclose Korean property, bank accounts, rental income, and the nature or value of other assets, as well as disputes concerning exemptions and transfers. Even if those allegations are not yet finally adjudicated, they remain matters under investigation in this Chapter 7 case, and the Court is not persuaded that the Debtor may invoke the protection of Chapter 7, obtain the benefit of the automatic stay, and then dismiss once the Trustee and creditors begin scrutinizing assets and transfers. That concern is consistent with *Bartee* and *Hickman*, which recognize that a debtor who invokes bankruptcy protection must also accept the attendant obligations of full disclosure and estate administration, and may not use dismissal to escape the consequences once the case becomes unfavorable. *Bartee*, 317 B.R. at 366; *Hickman*, 384 B.R. at 841-842.

Moreover, in determining whether "cause" exists under § 707(a), the Court considers whether the complained-of conduct is addressed by a more specific provision of the Bankruptcy Code. *Neary v. Padilla (In re Padilla)*, 222 F.3d 1184, 1191 (9th Cir. 2000); *Sherman v. SEC (In re Sherman)*, 491 F.3d 948, 969 (9th Cir. 2007). That principle is particularly relevant here because Philips argues, in part, that the Debtor filed this case on the eve of trial to halt the state court action and gain the benefit of the automatic stay. But *Sherman* makes clear that where the asserted abuse is a debtor's use of bankruptcy "as a refuge from the jurisdiction of another court," the Code provides a more direct and tailored remedy in § 362(d)(1): relief from stay for "cause." *Sherman*, 491 F.3d at 971-72. As the Ninth Circuit explained, "[p]reventing a debtor from taking advantage of the stay is a remedy tailored to the problem of improper avoidance of jurisdiction of another court," whereas dismissal under § 707(a) is "too powerful a medicine" for that problem because it eliminates the bankruptcy case altogether, including with respect to debts and estate issues beyond the pending litigation. *Id.* at 972. That reasoning is instructive here.
