Although "adequate information" is a flexible, case-specific concept, it must provide the irreducible minimum necessary to explain how the plan will be implemented. *In re Metrocraft Pub. Servs., Inc.*, 39 B.R. 567 (Bankr. N.D. Ga. 1984); *In re Michelson*, 141 B.R. 715, 718-19 (Bankr. E.D. Cal. 1992).

Here, the Disclosure Statement omits material information necessary for creditors to evaluate the proposed liquidation. It contains no current anticipated sale price or numerical liquidation analysis, provides no estimates of substantial professional and administrative expenses, does not explain how sale proceeds will be distributed if they are insufficient to satisfy all claims, and does not adequately disclose the basis for disputing Bian's secured claim or the effect of that dispute on distributions.

Likewise, as raised in Bian's Preliminary Objections [Dk. 140], the Disclosure Statement does not explain how the Trustee intends to fund the remaining entitlement work, professional fees, and administrative expenses where the Property generates no income and the Trustee's request for postpetition
