### **Tentative Ruling:**

Tentative for 9/17/25:

The Court is inclined to GRANT relief as requested.

Movant seeks relief from stay to continue her employment discrimination arbitration, expressly limiting recovery to available insurance. Neither the Debtor nor the Chapter 7 Trustee oppose. The only opposition comes from RSUI, the Debtor's insurer, which raises coverage defenses based on the self-insured retention.

Relief from stay proceedings are summary in nature and not the forum to adjudicate insurance coverage. See In re Johnson, 756 F.2d 738, 740 (9th Cir. 1985); Grella v. Salem Five Cent Sav. Bank, 42 F.3d 26, 31 (1st Cir. 1994). Movant has made a prima facie showing of cause under § 362(d)(1), shifting the burden under § 362(g)(2). With no objection from the Debtor or Trustee and noting that this is a Chapter 7 case in which the Debtor will not obtain a discharge, and with recovery limited to insurance, application of the Curtis/Plumberex factors favor relief. If no coverage exists, Movant recovers nothing, and the estate is not prejudiced.
