The Court is not prepared to rule on Movants' request for attorneys' fees because the record remains inconsistent and misleading.

The May 7, 2025 payoff demand [Dk. 209, Ex. 7] reflects that Trustee paid \$173,157.45 in attorneys' fees and costs, derived directly from the itemized fee statement attached to the payoff demand. Trustee's chart [Dk. 222] shows

\$420,368.25 paid in "unpaid charges." When compared to the May 7 payoff demand itemization of unpaid charges, the Court surmises that \$173,157.45 in attorneys' fees and costs were paid at closing as the amounts identified as withheld on the May 7 demand correspond with the amounts identified by Trustee in his chart as disputed (which do not include the attorneys' fees). On July 22, 2025, the Court awarded \$66,592 in the adversary without prejudice [Dk. 155], leaving \$106,565.45 unresolved by the Court's calculation.

Movants' Supplemental Chart [Dk. 220], however, suggests that only \$19,502.33 remains outstanding. Yet in footnote 4 to that filing, Movants acknowledge that the actual balance of unpaid Marshack Hays Wood fees is \$102,069.97. Thus, the record presents two different "outstanding" amounts: by the Court's calculation, \$106,565.45 remains, while Movants admit to \$102,069.97. The approximately \$4,500 difference appears to result from the way Movants reconciled their billing against the May 7 payoff.

The Court cannot adjudicate fees on such an unclear and internally inconsistent record.

Accordingly, the matter is CONTINUED to October 22, 2025, at 11:00 a.m. By no later than October 8, 2025, Movants shall file and serve a supplemental pleading, supported by declarations and detailed billing records, that:

- 1. Reconciles the \$173,157.45 reflected on the May 7 closing statement with the \$66,592 already approved, and explains precisely how the unpaid balance is calculated.
- 2. Explains the basis for claiming \$102,069.97 as "outstanding" while the Court calculates the unresolved balance as \$106,565.45.
- 3. Separately identifies any post-May 7, 2025 fees (including the \$19,502.33) and justifies why they are compensable under § 506(b).

The Trustee and other objecting parties may file responses no later than 7 days thereafter.
