This matter was continued from 11/6/24 to permit Debtor to address several requirements, as set forth in the tentative below from 11/6/24. Debtor was specifically cautioned that if Debtor does not precisely comply with the 11/6/24 tentative requirements, the Court will dismiss or convert this case at the 12/5/24 hearing.

While Debtor appears to have finally obtained a DIP account, despite this case being five months old, Debtor has not provided proof of any income with which to fund a plan.
