Deadline for the debtor to mail the approved disclosure statement, the Third Amended Plan, ballots for acceptance or rejection of the Third Amended Plan and to file and serve notice of: (1) the confirmation hearing and (2) the deadlines to return completed ballots to the debtor's counsel and to file objections to confirmation: **July 15, 2026.**

The debtor must serve the notice and the other materials (with the exception of the ballots, which should be sent only to creditors in impaired classes) on all creditors, parties who have requested special notice and the Office of the United States Trustee.

Deadline to return completed ballots to the debtor: **August 12, 2026.**

Deadline for the debtor to file and serve the debtor's brief and evidence, including declarations, in support of confirmation: **August 19, 2026.** Among other things, the debtor's brief must address whether the requirements for confirmation set forth in 11 U.S.C. § 1129 are satisfied. These materials must be served on the United States trustee and any creditor which returns a ballot rejecting the Plan.

Tentative Ruling:

On May 13, 2026, V-Red, Inc. ("Debtor") filed a voluntary chapter 11 petition. On May 27, 2026, Debtor filed its schedules and statement of financial affairs [doc. 9].

In its schedule A/B, Debtor does not identify any assets. In its schedule D, Debtor identifies two creditors with liens against real property located at 613-615 Grand Avenue, Los Angeles, California (the "Real Property"). In schedule D, Debtor states that the Real Property is encumbered by a lien held by Ventura County Credit Union ("VCCU") to secure a claim in the amount of \$5,900,000 and a disputed lien of The Green Law Group, LLP. In its schedule E/F, Debtor does not identify any unsecured creditors.

On May 29, 2026, the Court entered an *Order Setting Hearing on Status of Chapter 11 Case and Requiring Report on Status of Chapter 11 Case* (the "Order") [doc. 14]. The Order required:

[A]t least fourteen (14) days before the status conference, the debtor must: (a) file with the Court a Case Status Conference Report and (b) serve the Case Status Conference Report on the United States Trustee, all secured creditors, the official committee of unsecured creditors and its counsel (or on the twenty largest unsecured creditors if no committee has been appointed), and all other official committees.

Order, p. 3. Contrary to the Order, Debtor has not filed and served a case status conference report.

Debtor's monthly operating report for May 2026 was due on June 21, 2026; as of July 2, 2026, Debtor has not filed its monthly operating report.

Chapter 11

On May 27, 2026, the United States Trustee ("UST") filed a *Motion Under 11 U.S.C. § 1112(b) to Dismiss or, in the Alternative, to Convert* Case (the "Motion") [doc. 7]. The UST represents that Debtor has not submitted the following documents required under the UST Guidelines: (1) *Declaration of Debtor regarding Compliance with UST Guidelines and Requirements for Chapter 11 Debtors in Possession*, (2) a real property questionnaire, (3) evidence that Debtor closed all prepetition bank accounts, (4) evidence that Debtor has opened a debtor-in-possession bank account, (5) proof of appropriate insurance, (6) proof of required certificates and licenses, (7) projected cash flow statement for the first days of operation under chapter 11, (8) statement of major issues and timetable report, (9) an Employee Benefit Plan Questionnaire, (10) copies of the two most recent federal tax returns, (11) conformed copies of recorded petition in which county in which real property is owned, (12) a list of insiders, and (13) prepetition financial statements.

Debtor did not file a response to the Motion.

On June 25, 2026, VCCU filed a motion for relief from the automatic stay with respect to the Real Property [doc. 24]. VCCU alleges that its interest in the Real Property is not adequately protected and Debtor filed its case in bad faith. *Declaration of Paul Emanuels in Support of Motion for Relief from the Automatic Stay Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 362(d)(1)* [doc. 28].

VCCU further represents:

Debtor's Creditor meeting [pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 341(a)] *has already been continued twice* for Debtor's failure to appear and for Debtor's failure to provide the U.S. Trustee with any of the required documents or information. The third scheduled hearing is currently set for July 14, 2026.

Memorandum of Points and Authorities in Support of Motion for Relief from the Automatic Stay Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 362(d)(1) (emphasis in original) [doc. 24-1].

In light of the foregoing, and in accordance with 11 U.S.C. §§ 105(a), 349(a), and 1112(b)(1) and (4)(C), (E), (F) and (H), the Court will grant the Motion and dismiss this case with a 180-day bar to Debtor filing another bankruptcy petition.

Tentative Ruling:

On May 19, 2026, the debtor filed *Debtor's Chapter 11 Subchapter V Plan* (the "Plan") [doc. 51]. Attached as Exhibit 4 to the Plan are the debtor's projected income and expenses over 60 months (the "Plan Projections").

On June 10, 2026, the debtor filed his March and April monthly operating reports [docs. 53 and 54]. As of July 2, 2026, the debtor has not filed the May monthly operating report, which was due on June 21, 2026.

On June 17, 2026, the Court entered an *Order Setting Continued Chapter 11, Subchapter V Status Conference* (the "Order") [doc. 56]. The Order required, in part, that:

[N]o later than June 24, 2026, the debtor must submit an updated status report which addresses: (1) the debtor's efforts to generate postpetition rental income from the debtor's real property, and the basis for the debtor's projected rental income to be generated from the debtor's real property; (2) the efforts the debtor has made to obtain the consent of creditors for a consensual plan; (3) if the debtor expects that the plan will be a nonconsensual plan, i.e., a plan confirmed under 11 U.S.C. § 1191(b), why that is expected; and (4) whether the debtor's 2023, 2024 and 2025 tax returns have been filed with the applicable taxing authorities. The debtor's updated status report must be served on the debtor's 20 largest unsecured creditors, all secured creditors and the United States trustee.

On June 24, 2026, the debtor filed a Status Report (the "Status Report") together with supporting declarations [doc. 61]. The debtor represents that he has listed his real property in Indio, California for nightly rentals on various internet platforms, is taking steps to list the property for short-term monthly rentals, and his marketing efforts have resulted in at least two confirmed future bookings. *Declaration of Rami Bentov*, ¶¶ 2-3 [doc. 61]. The debtor, through counsel, has discussed the proposed Plan with at least three unsecured creditors. *Declaration of Stella Havkin*, ¶ 2 [doc. 61].

Regarding his tax returns, the debtor represents that his 2023 and 2024 tax returns have been filed with the applicable taxing authorities and his 2025 tax return will be filed within 45 days. *Id.*, ¶ 4; *Declaration of Rami Bentov*, ¶ 4.

Proposed dates and deadlines regarding confirmation of the Plan:

Hearing on confirmation of the Plan: **September 23, 2026 at 2:00 p.m.**

Deadline for the debtor to mail the Plan, ballots for acceptance or rejection of the Plan and to file and serve notice of: (1) the confirmation hearing and (2) the deadlines to return completed ballots to the debtor's counsel and to file objections to confirmation: **July 22, 2026.**

The debtor must include a copy of the Plan Projections in a size 11-point font (or larger) so that interested parties can meaningfully review the exhibit. Before the Plan and related documents can be served on interested parties, the debtor must amend the formatting of the Plan Projections currently filed at doc. 51.

The debtor must serve the notice and the other materials (with the exception of the ballots, which should be sent only to creditors in impaired classes) on all creditors, the subchapter V trustee and the United States trustee.

Deadline to return completed ballots to the debtor: **August 12, 2026.**

Deadline for the debtor to file and serve the debtor's brief and evidence, including declarations and the returned ballots, in support of confirmation: **August 26, 2026.** Among other things, the debtor's brief must address whether the requirements for confirmation set forth in 11 U.S.C. § 1191 are satisfied. These materials must be

served on the subchapter V trustee, the United States trustee and any creditor which returns a ballot rejecting the Plan.

Deadline to file and serve any objections to confirmation: **September 9, 2026.**

Deadline for the debtor to file and serve any reply to objections to confirmation: **September 16, 2026.**

Continued chapter 11 case status conference to be held at **2:00 p.m. on September 23, 2026.**

The subchapter V trustee must file and serve on the debtor, its counsel and any objecting creditor(s) a declaration, **no later than September 21, 2026**, which includes: (a) a discussion of any issues with the debtor's case and confirmation of the Plan; and (b) a summary of the discussions with the debtor and other material parties in interest regarding progress made toward a consensual chapter 11 plan.

The debtor must submit a scheduling order, incorporating the above dates, times and deadlines regarding confirmation of the Plan and the continued status conference, within seven (7) days.
