Tentative Ruling:

On July 1, 2026, Tykisha Stanford ("Debtor") filed her third amended chapter 13 plan (the "Plan") [doc. 55]. Although certain of Debtor's creditors, i.e., Sun West Mortgage Company, BMW Bank of North America, TD Bank, N.A. and Capital Community Bank, may have received a copy of the Plan via the Court's electronic noticing system (sent to their counsel), it appears that Onemain Financial Group, LLC was not served with a copy of the Plan.

Debtor did not attach to the Plan or separately file a proof of service of the Plan. Moreover, Debtor did not provide notice of the continued confirmation hearing and the deadline for creditors to file and serve objections to the Plan.

The Court will continue the hearing to **11:00 a.m. on August 11, 2026.**

In December 2025, Christopher Alcala and Kaitlyn Mae Alcala filed a chapter 13 petition, initiating case no. 1:25-bk-12451.

On June 8, 2026, Dionisio Alcala ("Movant"), father of the debtor Christopher Alcala ("Debtor"), filed the *Notice of Motion and Motion of Dionisio Alcala for Order (I) Determining that Levied Funds Are Not Property of the Bankruptcy Estate & (II) for Turnover and Release of the Levied Funds to Third-Party Owner Dionisio Alcala* (the "Motion") [doc. 22]. In the Motion, Movant requests that the Court determine that certain funds (the "Funds") levied from Movant's bank account at City National Bank (the "Account") are not property of Debtor's bankruptcy estate. In addition, Movant requests that the Court authorize and direct turnover of the Funds to Movant.

According to Movant, in November 2025, a judgment was entered against, among others, the debtors, in connection with Los Angeles Superior Court case styled *Channel Partners Capital, LLC v. CKA Enterprises LLC*, case no. 25CHCV02983 (the "State Court Case"). Movant asserts that, in December 2025, the Los Angeles County Sheriff served a notice of levy on City National Bank.

Movant represents that Debtor's name is on the Account. However, Movant states that Debtor has never contributed any funds to the Account. Movant further contends that Debtor has never withdrawn any funds from the Account. As of July 7, 2026, no response to the Motion has been filed.

In March 2026, Channel Partners Capital, LLC ("CPC") filed proof of claim no. 11-1 against the estate, asserting an unsecured claim in the amount of \$66,944.40.

According to CPC, its claim is based on a judgment. Proof of claim no. 11-1, p. 2. In its proof of claim, CPC states that notices should be sent to the following address:

The proof of service attached to the Motion indicates that, on June 8, 2026, Movant served the Motion and notice of the Motion on CPC, c/o Phillip A. Zunshine, Esq. However, Mr. Zunshine has not entered an appearance in this case. Moreover, Movant did not serve the Motion and notice of the Motion on CPC at the notice address identified on CPC's proof of claim. As a result, CPC may not have received notice of the Motion and the deadline to file any response. Consequently, the Court will continue the hearing.

No later than July 17, 2026, Movant must file and serve on CPC, at the notice address identified on CPC's proof of claim, and **to the attention of the person who signed the proof of claim**, notice of the continued hearing date and the deadline to file and serve a response to the Motion of **July 31, 2026**. To demonstrate that Movant has timely and properly served the Motion and notice, Movant must promptly file a properly completed proof of service of the Motion and notice.

#51.00 Creditor Ziad Corban and Corban Group, Inc.'s Objection to Debtor's Claim of Exemptions

Tentative Ruling:

The Court will overrule the objection as moot.

On April 15, 2026, Hassan Saad Shatila ("Debtor") filed a chapter 13 petition, initiating case no. 1:26-bk-10790. In his original schedule A/B, Debtor identified an interest in shares in Hayats Kitchen (the "Shares"), with an unknown value. Schedule A/B, ¶ 44 [doc. 15]. In his original schedule C, Debtor claimed an exemption in the Shares under Cal. Civ. Proc. Code ("CCP") § 703.140(b)(6), in an unknown amount. Schedule C, ¶ 2 [doc. 15].

On June 16, 2026, creditors Ziad Corban and Corban Group, Inc. ("Creditors") filed an objection to Debtor's claim of exemption in the Shares (the "Objection") [doc. 30]. In the Objection, Creditors assert that: (1) the Shares do not qualify for an exemption under 11 U.S.C. §522(b)(3) or CCP §703.140(b)(6); and (2) Debtor's claimed exemption is deficient on its face because Debtor did not indicate a dollar value of the Shares, which renders it impossible to determine whether the value of the Shares fall within the statutory cap under CCP §703.140(b)(6).

On June 30, 2026, Debtor filed amended schedules A/B and C [doc. 42] and an opposition to the Objection [doc. 45]. In his amended schedule A/B, Debtor identifies an interest in Hayats Kitchen, Inc. ("Hayats"), with a value of \$0. Amended schedule A/B, ¶ 19 [doc. 42]. In his amended schedule C, Debtor does not claim an exemption in his interest in the Shares or in Hayats. *See generally* amended schedule C [doc. 42].

Given that Debtor has filed an amended C, in which Debtor does not claim an exemption in his interest in the Shares, the Court will deny the Objection as moot.

Debtor must submit the order within seven days.
