Tentative Ruling:

The adversary proceeding will be dismissed due to Plaintiff's failure to prosecute the adversary proceeding. The Court previously issued an OSC re Dismissal after Plaintiff failed to appear at the status conference held on February 10, 2026. Plaintiff thereafter filed a response, and the Court discharged the OSC at the March 10, 2026 hearing. At that hearing, because Plaintiff had failed to file a proof of service demonstrating proper service on the United States Department of Education, the Court directed Plaintiff to obtain issuance of a new summons and properly serve the United States Department of Education. The Court also continued the status conference to May 19, 2026. Plaintiff failed to comply with the Court's directives. Specifically, Plaintiff did not obtain issuance of a new summons, did not file a proof of service showing proper service on the United States Department of Education, and failed to file a status report in advance of the continued status conference. Accordingly, the adversary proceeding is dismissed for failure to prosecute.
