Debtor filed an opposition to the motion.

The motion is GRANTED pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 362(d)(1) and (d) (2). The stay is terminated as to the debtor and the debtor's bankruptcy estate with respect to the movant, its successors, transferees and assigns. Movant may enforce its remedies to obtain possession of the property in accordance with applicable law, but may not pursue a deficiency claim against the debtor or property of the estate except by filing a proof of claim pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 501. **Appearances are required**.

Movant served the debtor with a three-day notice to quit the premises on December 17, 2023. Movant filed an unlawful detainer complaint on December 21, 2023. A judgment was entered on May 9, 2024 and a writ of possession for the Property was issued on May 24, 2024. Debtor filed the bankruptcy petition on June 21, 2024 in an apparent effort to stay enforcement of the unlawful detainer judgment. Debtor has been divested of her tenancy interest in the foreclosed residential property. See Eden Place, LLC v. Sholem Perl (In re Perl), 811 F.3d 1120, 11-27-28 (9th Cir. 2016) (execution of a writ of possession after unlawful detainer proceedings extinguished the occupant's legal and equitable possessory interests in the property). The motion is GRANTED pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 362(d)(1) and (d) (2) to permit movant, its successors, transferees and assigns, to enforce its remedies to repossess or otherwise obtain possession and dispose of its collateral pursuant to applicable law, and to use the proceeds from its disposition to satisfy its claim. Movant may not pursue any deficiency claim against the debtor or property of the estate except by filing a proof of claim pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 501. Since a chapter 7 case does not contemplate reorganization, the sole issue before the court when stay relief is sought under 11 U.S.C. § 362(d)(2) is whether the debtor has equity in the property. See e.g., Nev. Nat'l Bank v. Casgul of Nev., Inc. (In re Casgul of Nev., Inc.), 22 B.R. 65, 66 (9th Cir. BAP 1982); Ramco Indus. v. Preuss (In re Preuss), 15 B.R. 896 (9th Cir. BAP 1981). Appearances waived.

The subject property is subject to a lease. The lease matured on July 14, 2024. Debtor surrendered the vehicle on July 6, 2024. The trustee cannot administer the subject property for the benefit of creditors. The trustee has filed a no asset report. This is "cause" to terminate the stay under 11 U.S.C. § 362(d)(1).

The 14-day stay of FRBP 4001(a)(3) is ordered waived. **All other** relief is denied.
