#### **Tentative Ruling:**

Even when a party has failed to respond to a complaint and its default has been entered, a plaintiff is not entitled to a default judgment as a matter of right. 10 *Moore's Federal Practice—Civil,* ¶ 55.31 (Daniel R. Coquillette & Gregory P. Joseph eds. 3rd ed.). Entry of a default judgment is within the discretion of the court. *Eitel v. McCool,* 782 F.2d 1470, 1471 (9th Cir.1986). Default judgments are not favored, as the judicial process prefers determining cases on their merits whenever reasonably possible. *Id.* at 1472. Factors which the court may consider in exercising its discretion include:

(1) the possibility of prejudice to the plaintiff,

(2) the merits of plaintiff's substantive claim,

(3) the sufficiency of the complaint,

(4) the sum of money at stake in the action,

(5) the possibility of a dispute concerning material facts,

(6) whether the default was due to excusable neglect, and

(7) the strong policy underlying the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure favoring decisions on the merits.

*Id.* at 1471–72 (citing 6 *Moore's Federal Practice*—*Civil,* ¶ 55–05[s], at 55–24 to 55–26). In determining whether to exercise its discretion, courts also consider the factors traditionally used to determine whether a default judgment should be set aside: (a) whether the default was willful or culpable; (b) whether granting relief from the default would prejudice the opposing party; and (c) whether the defaulting party has a meritorious defense. *Id.* 

The court finds that the Complaint is sufficient and certain requests for relief requested therein are meritorious. It has not been shown to the court there is or may be any dispute concerning material facts. Defendant debtor, Cale Newman Dester ("Debtor"), has not contested any facts in this Adversary Proceeding, nor did he dispute facts presented in the Plaintiff's Declaration of Michael Wilkins In Support of Default Judgment [Docket No. 17]. Further,

there is no evidence of excusable neglect by the Debtor. Although the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure favor decisions on the merits through the crucible of litigation, Debtor has been given several opportunities to respond and there is no indication that Debtor has a meritorious defense or disputes Plaintiff's right to judgment in this Adversary Proceeding. The court finds that it is necessary and proper for the entry of a default judgment against the Debtor.

#### CONCLUSION

Upon consideration of the Complaint, Motion for Entry of a Default Judgment, and evidence presented in the accompanying supplemental pleadings, the court finds that certain relief as requested in the Complaint for a determination that certain debt owed to Plaintiff is non-dischargeable pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 523(a)(2)(A) for fraud and 523(a)(6) for willful and malicious injury is warranted because of actions taken by Debtor. Debtor fraudulently obtained Plaintiff's funds in the amount of \$15,171.05 through a scheme involving invalid checks. Thus, Debtor's discharge of debt owed to Torrance Community Federal Credit Union, the Plaintiff, with interest of \$1,913.60, is denied in the total amount of \$17,084.65 pursuant to §§ 523(a) (2)(A) and (a)(6).

The Motion for Entry of Default Judgment is granted as to the first and third cause of action and judgment shall be entered for Plaintiff consistent with this ruling. The Motion is denied as the the second cause of action under § 523(a) (2)(B).

Plaintiff shall lodge an appropriate order granting the Motion and separate judgment. **Appearances waived**.
